AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF OFF-ISLAND INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES AGAINST OPERATIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE TRANSITIONAL QUARTER BUDGET FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1979-SEPTEMBER 30, 1979.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The Department of Education is hereby authorized to make commitments in the following itemized categories and amounts against operational appropriations for the transitional quarter budget for the period July 1, 1979-September 30, 1979:

Funds committed under Section 1 of this Act shall not be disbursed prior to July 1, 1979; provided, however, vendors shall be promptly paid for products and services rendered upon release of the funds on July 1, 1979, notwithstanding provisions of the Executive Budget Act to the contrary.

Section 3. Subsection (b) of Section 2 of Public Law 15-6 is amended to read:

"(b) There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund a sum not to exceed Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) for use by the Committees on Education and Territorial-Federal Affairs to conduct an educational program on the provisions of the proposed Guam Constitution."

Section 4. Item B. of Section 3 of Public Law 15-7 is amended 1 to read: 2 For the operation of the Standing "B. 3 Committees, the Offices of the 4 Speaker and Legislative Secretary 5 and to provide contingency funds 6 for the Speaker, Vice-Speaker, 7 Legislative Secretary, each of 8 the Standing Committees and the 9 Majority Leader, as allocated 10 by the Committee on Rules \$1,467,000". 11 Section 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 19374 12 of the Government Code, the first half of property taxes for 1978 13 shall not become delinquent unless still unpaid as of July 31, 1979 14 and the deadline for payment is extended accordingly. 15 Section 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 19375 16 of the Government Code, the second half of property taxes for 1978 17 shall not become delinquent unless still unpaid as of September 30. 18 1979 and the deadline for payment is extended accordingly. 19 Section 7. Section 5 of this Act shall be effective retro-20 actively from February 20, 1979. 21 Section 8. A new Subsection (e) is added to Section 4006.2 22 of the Government Code to read: 23 "(e) As used in this section 'employees occupying per-24 manent positions' includes all elected officials except 25 members of the Board of Education." 26
