


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION
45402(b) (12) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM RELATING TO THE OFFER OR SALE
OF SECURITIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Item (12) of Subsection (b) of Section 45402
3 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed and reenacted to
4 read:

5 "(12). Any offer or sale of a security if (i) the
6 security or transaction is not subject to, or is exempted
7 from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of
8 1933, other than by reason of Section 3(a) of that Act, or
9 (ii) a registration statement relating to such security has
10 been filed under the Securities Act of 1933 and no stop
11 order or refusal order is in effect and no public proceeding
12 or examination looking toward such an order is pending
13 under that Act, provided that the issuer of such security
14 or a registered broker-dealer files with the Administrator
15 a notice of intention to sell such security in such form
16 as the Administrator may prescribe, together with a filing
17 fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)."

18 Section 2. Part One, Section 1.II.B.1 and 3 of Public Law
19 15-66 is amended to read as follows:

20 "II. PUBLIC SAFETY

21 B. Department of Public Safety

22 1. Director's Office,

23 not to exceed \$ 410,960

8 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from the General
9 Fund to the Commissioner's Council the sum of Four Thousand
10 Nine Hundred Forty Dollars (\$4,940) for the purpose of satisfying
11 the claims of annual leave payments as authorized in Section 2
12 of Public Law 15-75.

13 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from the General
14 Fund the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars
15 (\$2,759) to the Department of Corrections for unpaid wages and
16 benefits earned in Fiscal Year 1979.

17 Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from the General
18 Fund the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) to the
19 Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities,
20 resurfacing and fencing at the Yigo Baseball and Basketball
21 Fields.

22 Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from the General
23 Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to the
24 Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities at
25 the Agana Heights Baseball Field.

26 Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from the General
27 Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to the
28 Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities at
29 the Mangilao Baseball Field.
