AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REPART SECTION 45402(b) (12) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE OFFER OR SALE OF SECURITIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Item (12) of Subsection (b) of Section 45402 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed and reenacted to read:

"(12). Any offer or sale of a security if (i) the security or transaction is not subject to, or is exempted from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933, other than by reason of Section 3(a) of that Act, or (ii) a registration statement relating to such security has been filed under the Securities Act of 1933 and no stop order or refusal order is in effect and no public proceeding or examination looking toward such an order is pending under that Act, provided that the issuer of such security or a registered broker-dealer files with the Administrator a notice of intention to sell such security in such form as the Administrator may prescribe, together with a filing fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)."

Section 2. Part One, Section 1.II.B.1 and 3 of Public Law 15-66 is amended to read as follows:

Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Commissioner's Council the sum of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Dollars (\$4,940) for the purpose of satisfying the claims of annual leave payments as authorized in Section 2 of Public Law 15-75.

Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars (\$2,759) to the Department of Corrections for unpaid wages and benefits earned in Fiscal Year 1979.

Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) to the Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities, resurfacing and fencing at the Yigo Baseball and Basketball Fields.

Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to the Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities at the Agana Heights Baseball Field.

Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to the Department of Parks and Recreation for lighting facilities at the Mangilao Baseball Field.
