




AN ACT TO CANCEL CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. All provisions of law containing appropriations
3 for capital projects which were enacted into law thirty-six (36)
4 months prior to the effective date of this Act are hereby
5 repealed; however, this section shall only be applicable to
6 capital projects determined by the Governor no later than
7 February 29, 1980, to be financially not feasible or projects
8 determined to have been completed with idle balances remaining
9 in the project account. All such balances shall revert to the
10 applicable fund source from which the project was appropriated.

11 Section 2. On the effective date of this Act, any surplus
12 or lapsed funds remaining in the applicable fund source from
13 which the project was appropriated shall be applied to the
14 projects which were not cancelled by Section 1 of this Act and
15 which have not been completely funded.

16 Section 3. At the conclusion of any fiscal year, any surplus
17 or lapsed funds remaining in the applicable fund source from
18 which the project was appropriated shall be applied to projects
19 which were not cancelled by Section 1 of this Act and which have
20 not been completely funded.

1 Section 4. The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Manage-
2 ment Research shall report to the Legislature no later than March
3 31, 1980: (1) all projects cancelled by Section 1 of this Act
4 citing the provision of law repealed; (2) all projects to be
5 funded in accordance with Section 2 and Section 3 of this Act
6 and funds required; and (3) all expenditures made pursuant to
7 the provisions of this Act.
