


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill No. 524, "An Act to provide for children and youth Sunday and family Sunday", was on the 12th day of February 1980, duly and regularly passed.



AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CHILDREN AND
YOUTH SUNDAY AND FAMILY SUNDAY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. New Sections 325 and 326 are added to the
3 Government Code to read:

4 "Section 325. Children and Youth Sunday. The fourth
5 Sunday of April in each year shall be known as 'Children
6 and Youth Sunday' and is made a special day during which
7 people of Guam will consider the needs and accomplishments
8 of the children and youth of Guam. The Governor of Guam
9 shall issue a proclamation calling upon the people of Guam
10 to observe such event and shall appoint a committee to plan
11 and make appropriate arrangements for the observance of said
12 day.

13 Section 326. The Sunday following Children and Youth
14 Sunday in each year shall be known as 'Family Sunday'.
15 Family Sunday is made a special day in which the people of
16 Guam would consider the value and importance of the family.
17 The Governor of Guam shall issue a proclamation calling
18 upon the people of Guam to observe such event and shall
19 appoint a committee to plan and make appropriate arrange-
20 ments for the observance of the day."

21 Section 2. Section 201 of the Government Code of Guam is
22 amended to read:

23 "Section 201. Same. If any of the holidays enumerated
24 in Section 200, (b) through (p), inclusive, falls upon a

Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday, and if any of such holidays falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday; provided, however, that if the holiday results from a primary election or a run-off election held upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is not a holiday."
