AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 12227.1, 12227.2, 12227.3, AND 12227.4 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE A SUBSIDY TO INDIVIDUAL PERSONS LEASING CERTAIN HEAVY EQUIPMENT FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. New Sections 12227.1, 12227.2, 12227.3 and
12227.4 are added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 12227.1. Same. Rental from private company. Heavy duty tractors, plows and other such equipment may be leased from private companies licensed by the Director of Agriculture so long as the lessee shall use such heavy equipment for agricultural land clearing and other agricultural purposes only.

Section 12227.2. The rental provided for in Section 12227.1 above shall be subsidized at the rate of fifty percent (50%) in accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the Director.

Section 12227.3. License. The Director shall, in accordance with rules and regulations to be issued him, license such private companies to rent equipment in

accordance with the provisions of this Act and rules promulgated thereto.

Section 12227.4. Rules. The Director shall promulgate and disseminate printed rules and regulations dealing with the subject matter of this Act."

Section 2. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

Section 3. Section 4210.1 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"Section 4210.1. A retired member who subsequently becomes an employee not ineligible for membership under Section 4205 of the Government Code shall, upon becoming so employed, have his right to receive payment of his annuity suspended for the duration of his employment, but all other rights pertaining to his annuity provided by this Chapter, including automatic increases therein, shall be retained by him. The provisions of this Section shall not be applicable to any person employed by the Department of Education in order to implement the Chamorro Language and Culture Program in Guam schools as mandated by Section 11682 of the Government Code provided that such person occupies a position requiring expertise in the Chamorro language and culture for which no other qualified applicants were available."
