AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$78,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO RESURFACE NAVAL MAGAZINE ROAD AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$78,000) from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works to repair and resurface Naval Magazine Road.

Section 2. Any available balance of the appropriation in Section 1 of this measure after September 30, 1980 shall revert back to the Territorial Highway Fund.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority the sum of One Million Six Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$1,661,639). Said sum is to be expended by Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for the following obligations:

1) Government of Guam Retirement
Fund Contributions \$664,194

2) Withholding Taxes \$997,445.

Section 4. All sums owed to the Guam Memorial Hospital 1 Authority by the Departments of Corrections, Education, Public Safety and the Superior Court through December 31, 1979 are hereby forgiven. The sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars Section 5. (\$250,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the plans and construction of an indoor gymnasium at Luis P. Untalan 7 Junior High School in Barrigada. Twe1ve Wesection 6. The sum of Twenty-Two-Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) (\$22,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the 10 refurbishing of the Basketball and Volleyball courts in 11 12 | Inarajan. Section 7. Section 6 of Public Law 14-120 is hereby amended 13 to read: "Section 6. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) 15 is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the 16 General Fund for the improvements at the Guzman Memorial 17 Baseball Field in the municipality of Santa Rita."

Section 8. The sum of Twenty-Thousand Dollars (\$29,000) 18 19 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to upgrade the field 20 lighting system of the Jose U. Atoigue Baseball Park in Chalan 21 22 Pago. In complete satisfaction of all claims, demands 23 Section 9. and causes of actions of Maria Q. Ariano which do arise out of 24 Civil Case No. 240-73, the sum of Twenty-Two-Thousand-Two-Hundred 25 Fifty-Dollars (\$22-,250) is hereby appropriated from the General 26 Fund to satisfy her claim arising out of judgement and interest

accrued to date by Civil Case No. 240-73.
