




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE ONE (1) FROM
ROUTE FOUR (4) TO CAMP WATKINS ROAD.

1 WHEREAS, there has been significant increases in the
2 population of the central area of Guam with the advent of
3 cluster housing development and increase business activities in
4 Tamuning; and

5 WHEREAS, it is estimated that the island's population will
6 double by the year 2000; and

7 WHEREAS, an increase in commercial activities has and will
8 continue to accompany a population increase in Guam; and

9 WHEREAS, approximately eighty percent (80%) of the traffic
10 on Route One (1) originates or terminates in northern Guam; and

11 WHEREAS, Route One is in various stages of disrepair; and

12 WHEREAS, vehicles are the only means of transportation on
13 Guam and can be considered a necessity; and

14 WHEREAS, there are forty six thousand three hundred
15 (46,300) vehicles daily average traversing Route One; and

16 WHEREAS, further housing development in the northern half
17 of Guam would compound the existing traffic congestion along
18 Route One; and

1 WHEREAS, during a two year period, there were 300 accidents
2 on Route One and indicating a growing need for highway and
3 requirements for highway safety; now, therefore,

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
6 balance of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Two Million
7 One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,100,000) consisting of One
8 Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) in
9 Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Grants and Three Hundred
10 Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) in local funds for the reconstruc-
11 tion of a highway improvement project within the limits specified
12 herein:

13	<u>PROJECTS</u>	<u>LOCAL</u>	<u>FEDERAL</u>	<u>TOTAL</u>
14	1. Route One (1) Reconstruction			
15	From Route Four (4) to			
16	Camp Watkins Road	\$300,000	\$1,800,000	\$2,100,000.

17 Section 2. The use of local funds in advance of the federal
18 grant is authorized to be expected, subsequent to the actual
19 awarding of federal money.

20 Section 3. The appropriation made in Section 1 and the
21 authorization for local funds' use shall expire on December 31,
22 1981.

23 Section 4. The sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) is
24 appropriated from the unexpended balance of the Tourist
25 Attraction Fund to the Guam Visitors Bureau for the design,
26 construction and installation of two concrete memorials,
27 commemorating the 300th Anniversary of Inarajan, the oldest
28 village on Guam.

29 Section 5. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is
30 appropriated from the unexpended balance of the Tourist

1 Attraction Fund to the Guam Visitors Bureau for the renovation
2 of the Magellan Memorial Monument in Umatac.

3 Section 6. A sum not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars
4 (\$50,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of
5 the Governor of Guam for the contracting of a financial advisor
6 on the development of Guam's Offshore Lending Facilities and the
7 development of Guam as a Regional Services Center.

8 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated the amount of One
9 Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$199,700)
10 from the General Fund to construct canopies on the following
11 schools:

12	a. Agueda Johnston Junior High School	\$22,700
13	b. Maria Ulloa Elementary School	\$12,000
14	c. San Miguel Elementary School	\$25,000
15	d. Agana Heights Elementary School	\$20,000
16	e. Agat Elementary School	\$20,000
17	f. Vocational Technical High School	\$100,000.

18 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Seven
19 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500) from the General Fund to
20 the Guam Grand Prix Racing Commission to undertake its feasibi-
21 lity study as mandated by Public Law 15-28.

22 Section 9. The sum of ^{TWENTY-FIVE} ~~Fifty~~ Thousand Dollars ^(\$25,000) ~~(\$50,000)~~ is
23 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
24 Parks and Recreation for the repair of the Merizo launching ramp.
