




AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 23328 AND 23328.1  
TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE  
TO ESTABLISHING A MAIL ORDER VEHICLE  
REGISTRATION NOTIFICATION PROGRAM AND  
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFORE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. New Sections 23328 and 23328.1 are hereby added  
3 to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 23328. The Department of Revenue and  
5 Taxation shall initiate a Mail Order Vehicle Registration  
6 Notification Program, which shall consist of notification  
7 annually to all vehicle owners of Guam of such time an  
8 owner shall register and license his vehicle as provided  
9 in this Title. The notification issued by the Department  
10 of Revenue and Taxation shall include a breakdown of all  
11 charges to be paid by the owner. Such registration  
12 notification form shall have all fees totaled, except  
13 that a subtotal shall be listed prior to the cost of  
14 mailing being listed and the final total. Vehicle  
15 owners are required to promptly pay the final total  
16 listed by mailing the payment to the Department of  
17 Revenue and Taxation or personally making payment to the  
18 Treasurer of Guam. The cost of mailing shall be One  
19 Dollar (\$1.00) for license plates, fifty-cents (\$0.50)

1 for decals and fifty-cents (\$0.5) for the mailing of  
2 any other form, title decal or device provided for in  
3 this Act; except that the Department of Revenue and Taxation  
4 may adjust any mailing costs to provide for additional fees  
5 the U.S. Postal Service may charge.

6 Failure by an owner of a vehicle to receive registra-  
7 tion notification as provided for in this Act shall not in  
8 any manner relieve such person from the obligation of proper  
9 and timely registration and licensing and such person shall  
10 be subject to any penalties prescribed by this Act.

11 Section 23328.1. Payment of Registration Fees and  
12 License Plates. Payments for registration fees and license  
13 plates may be made by the applicant's personal or company  
14 check or U.S. Postal Service Money Order which shall be  
15 made payable to the Treasurer of Guam and may be mailed to  
16 the Department of Revenue and Taxation or may be paid in  
17 cash to the Treasurer of Guam.

18 Section 2. Section 23327 of the Government Code of Guam is  
19 hereby amended to read:

20 "Section 23327. Registration. Renewal. An owner  
21 applying for renewal of vehicle registration shall make  
22 application to the Department of Revenue and Taxation  
23 during the month in which his registration expires by  
24 mailing the registration card issued by the Department for  
25 use at time of renewal and by payment of the full annual  
26 fee for such vehicle through personal check, company check  
27 or U.S. Postal Service Money Order as provided in this  
28 Title or by personally presenting the registration card to  
29 the department."

1 Section 3. Section 23329, Subsection (b) is hereby amended  
2 to read:

3 "(b) Every application for the renewal of a license  
4 shall be made through the mail or in person during the  
5 month the registration expires but if mailed, it shall be  
6 postdated by midnight of the last day of the month in which  
7 the registration expires."

8 Section 4. The Director of the Department of Revenue and  
9 Taxation is hereby directed to prepare for the implementation of  
10 the Mail Order Vehicle Registration Notification Program no later  
11 than October 1, 1980 and shall include in his budget proposal for  
12 Fiscal Year 1981 such sums as are necessary to carry out the  
13 intent of this Act.

14 Section 5. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is  
15 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
16 Revenue and Taxation for the preparation and implementation of  
17 the Mail Order Vehicle Registration Notification Program as  
18 provided in this Act.

19 Section 6. Section 6500.05 of the Government Code of Guam  
20 is amended to read:

21 "Section 6500.05. Limitation on filing. All claims  
22 under this Act must be filed with the Attorney General  
23 according to the same time limitations for commencing  
24 similiar claims as provided for under Section 312 through  
25 Section 363, inclusive, of the Code of Civil Procedure, as  
26 amended or reenacted."

27 Section 7. A new Subsection (e) is added to Section 10590  
28 of the Government Code to read:

29 "(e) 'Self-construction' means a project or operation  
30 performed by the owner for his own personal needs on his

1 own premises; a self-constructed/performed project or  
2 operation shall otherwise be deemed performed by a  
3 contractor."

4 Section 8. Subsection (g) of Section 10501 of the Govern-  
5 ment Code is amended to read:

6 "(g) Any person who undertakes by himself or through  
7 his employees any project or operation for himself; and".
