AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (14) TO SECTION 9306 AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 9316.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO REPORTING AN ABORTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (14) is added to Section 9306 of the Government Code to read:

"(14). 'Abortion' means the purposeful termination of a human pregnancy after implantation of a fertilized ovum, by any person, including the pregnant woman herself, with an intention other than to necessarily produce a live birth or to remove a dead unborn fetus."

Section 2. A new Section 9316.1 is added to the Government

"Section 9316.1 Abortion Report. (a) An individual abortion report for each abortion shall be completed by her attending physician. The report shall be confidential and it shall not contain the name of the woman involved. This report shall include:

- (1) the patient number;
- (2) the name and address of the abortion facility or hospital;
 - (3) the date of the abortion;
- (4) the zip code or other residential identification of the pregnant woman;
 - (5) the age of the pregnant woman;

2	(7) the marital status of the pregnant woman;
3	(8) the number of previous pregnancies;
4	(9) the number of years of education of the
5	pregnant woman;
6	(10) the number of living children;
7	(11) the number of previous induced abortions;
8	(12) the date of the last induced abortion;
9	(13) the date of the last live birth;
10	(14) the method of contraception used, if any,
11	at the time of conception;
12	(15) the date of the beginning of the last
13	menstrual period;
14	(16) the medical condition of the woman at the
15	time of abortion;
16	(17) the RH type of pregnant woman;
17	(18) the type of abortion procedure used;
18	(19) the complications, if any;
19	(20) the type of procedure done after the abortion;
20	(21) the type of family planning recommended;
21	(22) the type of additional counseling given, if
22	any;
23	(23) the signature of attending physician; and
24	(24) the certification provided for in this
25	Section.
26	(b) An individual complication report for any post-
27	abortion care performed upon a woman shall be completed by
28	the physician providing such post-abortion care. This
29	report shall include:
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the name and address of the abortion (2) 2 facility or hospital where the abortion was performed; 3 4 and the nature of the abortion complication 5 diagnosed or treated. 6 All abortion reports shall be signed by the 7 attending physician and shall be submitted to the Guam 8 Memorial Hospital Medical Records Section within thirty 9 (30) days from the date of the abortion. All complication 10 reports shall be signed by the physician providing the 11 post-abortion care and submitted to the Guam Memorial 12 Hospital Medical Records Section within thirty (30) days 13 from the date of the post-abortion care. 14 A copy of the abortion report shall be made a 15 part of the medical record of the patient of the facility 16 or hospital in which the abortion was performed. 17 The Guam Memorial Hospital Medical Records 18 Section shall be responsible for collecting all abortion 19 reports and complication reports, and collating and 20 evaluating all data gathered therefrom, and shall annually 21 publish a statistical report based on such data, from 22 abortions performed in the previous calendar year. 23 The Guam Memorial Hospital Medical Records Section 24 shall make available to physicians performing abortions in 25 the territory of Guam, forms for both abortion reports and 26 post-abortion care reports, as provided in Subsections (a) 27 and (b) of this Section. 28 All information in abortion reports and post-29 abortion care reports and the reports themselves shall be 30 - 3 -

the date of the abortion;

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confidential. Information and records may be disclosed only in communications between qualified professional persons in the provision of services or in statistical form for research purposes as required by Subsection (e) of this Section.

- (h) Any person who releases confidential information in violation of Subsection (g) of this Section shall be quilty of a misdemeanor.
- (i) Any person may bring an action against an individual who has wilfully and knowingly released confidential information about such person in violation of Subsection (g) of this Section for the greater of the following amounts:
 - (1) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); or
 - if any, sustained by the plaintiff; reasonable attorney's fees and the costs of the action. It is not a prerequisite to an action under this Subsection that the plaintiff suffer or be threatened with actual damages."
- Section 3. Item (9) is added to Subsection (b) of Section 49005 of the Government Code to read:
 - "(9) to arrange for the burial of any fetus not claimed by its mother or father within thirty (30) days".
