AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARY AND ECONOMIC ZONE FOR THE JURISDICTION OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Subsection (a) of 1GCA402 is amended to read:

"Section 402. Boundaries; Territorial. (a) The boundaries of Guam run two hundred (200) geographical miles seaward from the low-water mark; provided, however, that where there are islands or reefs along or adjacent to the shores of Guam, the boundary line runs two hundred (200) geographical miles seaward from the outermost of such islands or reefs; provided, further, that in the case of all harbors and bays, the boundary line runs two hundred (200) geographical miles seaward from a line drawn in front of each harbor along the outermost works and installation thereof and two hundred (200) geographical miles seaward from a line drawn from headland to headland across the mouth of each bay."

Section 2. The territory of Guam shall exercise exclusive rights to determine the conditions and terms of all scientific research, management, exploration and exploitation of all ocean resources and all sources of energy and prevention of pollution within the economic zone, including pollution from outside the zone which poses a threat within the zone.
