AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 59819 AND 8982 AND TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER XIV-C TO TITLE IX OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE VETERANS' BONUSES TO WAKE ISLAND GUANANIAN WORKERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 59019 of
the Government Code (enacted by Public Law 14-126) is amended
to read:

"(a) All tax revenue paid to Guam pursuant to Section 59010 of the Government Code, shall be deposited in the Veterans Bonus Fund hereby established and is appropriated from the expenditures hereafter authorized. Expenditures shall be made from the fund for the purpose of paying to eligible veterans, Guam Combat Patrol members, and no more than forty eight (48) Wake Island Guamanian Workers and Civilian Scouts the benuses authorized by Chapters XIV-A XIV-B, XIV-C and XV, Title IX of the Government Code, as

it may, from time to time, be amended or for repayment of any indebtedness incurred pursuant to Subsection (b) of this Section.

(b) The Governor of Guam is authorized to incur indebtedness, with the consent of the Legislature by resolution, as to the terms of the loan, for the purpose of paying to eligible persons the bonuses authorized by Chapters XIV-A, XIV-B, XIV-C and XV, Title IX of the Government Code. The Governor may assign, pledge or grant a security interest in the tax revenue payable to the government of Guam pursuant to Section 59010 of the Government Code. Repayment of the loan shall be guaranteed by the government of Guam out of its revenues."

Section 2. Application for bonuses. All applications for bonuses authorized by Chapter XIV-C of Title IX must be made to the Office of Veteran's Affairs on or before May 30, 1980.

Each applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs evidence of his eligibility for a veteran's bonus. Eligibility may be evidenced by authenticated copies of records or certificates issued by the Department of Defense, U. S. Military Service Department, or any other authorized agency having such evidence in its possession.

Section 3. A new Chapter XIV-C is added to Title IX of the Government Code to read:

"CHAPTER XIV-C

Bonus for Wake Island Guamanian Workers
Section 8989. Creation of bonus. In honor of the
Wake Island Workers who have received inadequate
recognition from the United States Government, and little
prior recognition from the government of Guam, there are

hereby authorized to be paid to each of the Wake Island Workers, or his survivor or survivors, bonuses in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).

Section 8989.1. Eligibility for a bonus. The Governor shall prepare a list of all bona fide Wake Island Workers, which list shall govern eligibility for bonuses authorized by this Chapter. Each eligible worker, or his survivor or survivors, shall apply for such bonuses to the Governor, who upon satisfactory proof that such applicants were Wake Island Workers or are such a bona fide worker's survivor or survivors, shall certify to the Treasurer of Guam the eligibility of such applicants for such bonuses, and the Treasurer shall thereupon pay such bonuses to such applicants."

Section 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Veterans Bonus Fund the sum of One Hundred Twenty
Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) to satisfy the intent of this Act.
