Section 15. A sum not to exceed Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Bollars (\$37,500) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Governor of Guam for Guam's contribution to the Pacific Basin Development Council and for other purposes.

Section 10. There is appropriated the sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the completion of the 12 % construction of the Barrigada Baseball Field (Project No. 660-5-1057-L-BAR), which shall include a lighting system.

There is hereby appropriated from the General Section 17. Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) for the Fund the sum of Fort purpose of planning, designing and constructing jogging facilities, to include shower stalls and locker rooms and other related facilities at the Paseo de Susana.

Section 18. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for the improvements, including paving, of all village streets in Tamuning-Tumon.
