AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 43.51 TO THE CRIMINAL AND CORRECTIONAL CODE TO DEFINE THE CRIME OF THEFT OF UTILITY SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 1 Section 1. A new Section 43.51 is added to the Criminal and Correctional Code to read: 3

"Section 43.51. A person is guilty of theft if he knowingly tampers with, alters or by-passes meters for the purpose of obtaining electrical power, gas or water without paying compensation to the entity providing such services. A person commits theft if he knowingly diverts telephone service, electrical power, gas or water to his own benefit or to the benefit of another not entitled thereto with the intent to avoid payment to the entity providing such service."

Section 2. Subsection (d) of Section 21610 of the Government 13 Code is amended to read: 14

The provisions requiring contracts, bids or "(d) notices shall not apply to the procurement of professional or technical services, for revenue producing equipment such as telephones, mobile telephones, switchboards and other consumer oriented equipment nor to the procurement of replacement parts required by the Authority."
