




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 499, "An Act relative to funding sources of libraries in Guam", was on the 10th day of April 1980, duly and regularly passed.



Introduced by T. V. C. Tanaka

AN ACT RELATIVE TO FUNDING SOURCES OF
LIBRARIES IN GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 42002 of the Government Code is amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 42002. Use. The library shall be
5 available for use by all persons in Guam in
6 accordance with the rules and regulations
7 promulgated by the Board. However, the Board
8 shall have the authority to impose fines for lost
9 books, late return of books or other misuses of
10 the library resources. The Board shall also
11 have the authority to establish fees for other
12 services provided by the library."

13 Section 2. Section 42017 of the Government Code is repealed
14 and reenacted to read:

15 "Section 42017. Custody of funds. Funds
16 received by the library pursuant to Sections 42002
17 and 42015 of this Chapter shall be for the exclusive
18 use of the library and shall be kept in the custody
19 of the Treasurer of Guam and disbursed under
20 authority of the Board."

21 Section 3. A new Section 11125 is added to the Government
22 Code to read:

23 "Section 11125. School libraries. (a) The
24 librarians and administrators of the elementary
25 schools shall formulate proposed rules for

1 elementary school libraries, including, but not limited
2 to fines for lost books, late return of books and other
3 misuses of library resources; management of donations
4 for the purchase of books and other resource materials
5 and procedures for receipt of gifts of books and other
6 resource materials. The proposed rules shall be
7 submitted to the Director for approval. The Director
8 shall submit the proposed rules after acting on them to
9 the Board of Education. The Rules shall become effective
10 upon approval of the Board of Education, subject to the
11 provisions of the Administrative Adjudication Act.

12 (b) The librarians and administrators of the
13 junior high schools shall formulate proposed rules
14 for junior high school libraries, including, but not
15 limited to fines for lost books, late return of books
16 and other misuses of library resources; management
17 of donations for the purchase of books and other
18 resource materials and procedures for receipt of
19 gifts of books and other resource materials. The
20 proposed rules shall be submitted to the Director
21 for approval. The Director shall submit the proposed
22 rules after acting on them to the Board of Education.
23 The Rules shall become effective upon approval of the
24 Board of Education, subject to the provisions of the
25 Administrative Adjudication Act.

26 (c) The librarians and administrators of the
27 high schools shall formulate proposed rules for senior
28 high school libraries, including, but not limited to
29 fines for lost books, late return of books and other
30 misuses of library resources; management of donations

1 for the purchase of books and other resource materials
2 and procedures for receipt of gifts of books and other
3 resource materials. The proposed rules shall be
4 submitted to the Director for approval. The Director
5 shall submit the proposed rules after acting on them
6 to the Board of Education. The Rules shall become
7 effective upon approval of the Board of Education,
8 subject to the provisions of the Administrative
9 Adjudication Act.

10 (d) Funds received by school libraries as fines,
11 as donations or from fund-raising activities shall not
12 be deposited in the General Fund but shall be deposited
13 in a savings and loan association account or a commercial
14 bank account to be used for purchase of books and
15 resource materials by the library which collected the
16 fund. The Board of Education, subject to the provisions
17 of the Administrative Adjudication Act shall establish
18 procedures for school libraries to hold and expend funds
19 collected from fines, received as donations or through
20 fund-raising activities. The Board's procedures shall
21 provide that the funds may be expended upon order of
22 the school's administrator or acting administrator and
23 the school librarian. The Board's procedures shall
24 require the school or the librarian to maintain
25 financial records of all funds received by the library
26 and expenditures thereof. The school administrator and
27 librarian shall submit an annual report no later than
28 July 31 on the library's funds to the Director of
29 Education and the Territorial Auditor."
