AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 688 OF THE CIVIL PROCEDURE CODE RELATIVE TO RELEASE FROM LEVY OF PROPERTY LIABLE TO EXECUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 688 of the Civil Procedure Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 688. Property liable to execution: not affected until levied on. All goods, chattels, moneys or other property, both real and personal, or any interest therein, of the judgment debtor, not exempt by law, and all property and rights of property seized and held under attachment in the action, are liable to execution. Shares and interests in any corporation or company, and debts and credits, and all other property, both real and personal, or any interests in either real or personal property, and all other property not capable of manual delivery, may be levied upon or released from levy in like manner as like property may be attached or released from attachment, except that a copy of the complaint in the action from which the writ issued need not accompany the writ; provided, that no cause of action nor judgement as such, nor license issued by this territory to engage in any business, profession, or activity shall be subject to

levy or sale on execution. Until a levy, the property is not affected by the execution; but no levy shall bind any property for a longer period than one (1) year from the date of the issuance of the execution, except a levy on the interests or claims of heirs, devisees, or legatees in or to assets of deceased persons remaining in the hands of executors or administrators, thereof prior to distribution and payment. However, an alias execution may be issued on said judgment and levied on any property not exempt from execution."

Section 2. The Compiler of Laws shall assign new section numbers in Title I of the Guam Code Annotated to Sections 325 and 326 of the Government Code enacted in Public Law 15-105. Sections 325 and 326 as enacted in Public Law 15-105 shall not be deemed repealed by Public Law 15-104.
