AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNOR TO SUBDIVIDE INTO RESIDENTIAL LOTS CERTAIN GOVERNMENT-OWNED LAND IN UMATAC, AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF LOTS THEREAT TO CERTAIN PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF CUAM:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Governor of Guam is authorized to subdivide into residential lots, each of which shall contain no less than five thousand four hundred (5,400) nor more than ten thousand (10,000) square feet for sale pursuant to the provisions of this Act, the government real property except the Umatac Subdivision as identified in Section 13965.1 situated within the municipality of Umatac. The government shall subdivide and sell only those parcels of government land that are occupied at the time of the effective date of this Act.

Section 2. The subdivided lots shall be sold only to persons who own no land in the territory of Guam, qualified to own land in Guam and who are tenants of any part or portion of the said government property; provided, however, if a person owns property in Umatac which is not developable as a residential site then he may exchange property equal in value for a lot if he meets the other qualifications set forth in Sections 1 and 3 of this Act. The subdivided lot shall be sold at less than fair market value of the lots and less than the cost expended by

government of Guam in subdividing said lots but in no case shall be more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500). The conveyance shall be subject to a right of re-entry by the government of Guam if the grantee sells any of the conveyed property within (5) years after the date of execution of the deed by the Governor.

Section 3. In carrying out the mandate of this Act, the Governor shall sell or exchange the subdivided lots within the municipality of Umatac to the following persons if they meet the requirements set forth in Section 2 of this Act:

Chapter V of this Title shall also not apply to land which has been owned in fee simple for a period of not less than five (5) years by a person who divides said land among his living children or their descendants by way of inter vivos gift; provided, however, that such land shall be deeded to said children or descendants in fee simple and said deeds shall contain alienation clauses to the effect that the children or descendants shall not give, sell or lease such lots for a period of at least five (5) years, and further provided that before the map be filed for record, the Territorial Planner or the Commission shall require street and utility easements on said land to insure lot divisions consistent with the general plan and that the minimum size of each lot shall be no less than ten thousand (10,000) square feet. The deed transferring the property may provide that the children or descendants may mortgage the property for the purpose of constructing a residence on the property."

Section 6. Section 3 of Public Law 12-226 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law 12-61 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, the Governor of Guam and the Director of the Department of Land Management shall not sell, lease or exchange government owned property without the prior approval of the Legislature. This section shall not apply to leases made pursuant to Section 13506 of Chapter VI of the Government Code of Guam."
