AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. (a) Each pay range schedule set forth in
Section 4103 of the Government Code is amended by adding the
amount of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) to each pay step in
each pay range.

(b) The salary rate of each position in the government which is not provided for under Section 4103 of the Government Code is, in addition to such other salary increases as would be applicable, increased in the amount of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) per annum. The increase authorized by this Subsection shall not apply to any position for which the salary rate has been increased by Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) or more per annum since January 1, 1980 as a result of an agency-wide salary adjustment. The provisions of this Subsection shall not

apply to elected positions, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court, Judges of the Superior Court and heads of departments, agencies and authorities.

Section 2. Section 1 of this Act shall become effective on July 6, 1980. Prior to September 1, 1980, the Governor, by Executive Order, may augment the salary increase provided for in Section 1 by an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) upon the finding that the financial situation of the government is such that the additional salary increase can be funded.

Section 3. A new Section 4103.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 4103.1. Cost of Living Allowance. Beginning October 1, 1982 and annually for five (5) years thereafter, the Governor, by an Executive Order, shall increase in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) thereof the salary of all government positions.

Section 4. Notwithstanding other provisions of law to the contrary, the amount of each service retirement annuity, disability annuity and survivor's annuity paid pursuant to the provisions of Chapter III, Title V of the Government Code shall be increased Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700) per year to be effective on July 6, 1980. The increase provided pursuant to this Section shall be in addition to that provided in Section 11 of Public Law 14-87. The provisions of this Section shall apply only to annuitants receiving benefits on July 6, 1980.

Section 5. A new Subsection (e) is added to Section 4211 of the Government Code to read:

"(e) Beginning October 1, 1982 and annually for five (5) years thereafter, the Governor by an Executive Order

shall increase in an amount not to exceed ten percent 1 (10%) thereof, all the service retirement annuities, 2 disability annuities or survivor's annuities which are 3 less than or equal to Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) per annum and in an amount not to exceed seven percent 5 (7%) thereof all the service retirement annuities, 6 disability annuities or survivor's annuities which are 7 greater than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) per annum. The provisions of this Subsection shall not be effective 9 unless an amount necessary to fund the annual increase 10 has been appropriated from the General Fund to the 11 Retirement Fund. 12 Section 6. The sum of Five Million Two Hundred Fifty 13 Thousand Dollars (\$5,250,000) is appropriated from the General 14 15 Fund to implement Sections 1 and 2. Section 7. The sum of One Million Two Hundred Sixty 16

Section 8. Section 23 of Public Law 15-132 is amended to read:

"Section 23. The sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$1,700) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Commissioners Council to provide temporary office space for the Umatac Commissioner's Office."

Section 9. Section 6 of Public Law 15-132 is amended to read:

"Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) to the Department of Public Health and Social

Services, Communicable Disease Control Division, for the off-island travel of indigent patients of the Department. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be made subject to the approval of the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services, and shall be made in compliance with all criteria set for indigent patient care by the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority. The authority for expenditures from this appropriation shall expire September 30, 1980, and all remaining balances from this appropriation shall thereafter revert to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund."

Section 10. Section 2 of Public Law 15-119 is amended to read:

"Section 2. Application for bonuses. All application for bonuses authorized by Chapter XIV-C of Title IX must be made to the Office of Veteran's Affairs on or before June 30, 1980. Each applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs evidence of his eligibility for a veteran's bonus. Eligibility may be evidenced by authenticated copies of records or certificates issued by the Department of Defense, U. S. Military Service Department, or any other authorized agency having such evidence in its possession."

Section 11. A new Subsection (o) is added to Section 49003 of the Government Code to read:

"(o) Arrange of line of credit not to exceed One
Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Bollars (\$1,550,000)
with banks or other lending institutions licensed on Guam.
All terms of the line of credit agreement shall be
negotiated by the Authority in the best interests of the

people of Guam. The terms of the line of credit agreement 1 shall include the following: The line of credit shall be used by the Authority

when a cash shortage which hampers the operation of the hospital is imminent, provided that the line of credit shall not be used to finance capital improvements. Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) which is borrowed by the Authority shall be used for the purpose of getting the accounting records of the Authority in proper order and ready to audit no later than August 1, 1981.

- No charge shall be levied by a lender for opening the line of credit.
- The interest rate shall be subject to negotiation between the Authority and the lender. Such interest rate shall be computed on a monthly average and based on the actual amount extended to the Authority.
- Interest earned by the lender shall be exempt from taxation by the government of Guam.
- The Authority may pledge only its liquid assets as security for repayment of the loan.
- Any money borrowed shall be repaid within one (1) year. In no case shall any amount borrowed be refinanced permitting repayment more than one (1) year after the loan is made.

Section 12. Part One, Section 1., Subsections VIII.B.1 and 2. of Public Law 15-66 are amended to read:

#### "B. Commissioners Council

- 1. Administration, not to exceed \$ 79,542
- 2. Commissioners of Guam, not to exceed

\$561,883."

Section 13. The sum of One Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Dollars (\$165,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency for the purpose of extending the sewer line along Bishop Clano Road within the municipality of Santa Rita.

Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund the sum of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000) for the improvement and maintenance of the Tumon Beach area covering the immediate vicinity of the Guam Hilton Hotel to the Guam Hotel Okura.

Section 15. The appropriation made in Section 14 of this Act shall be administered by the Department of Parks and Recreation in coordination with the Cuam Visitors Bureau. The project shall be performed by a private contractor who shall be selected in accordance to government of Guam's prescribed rules, regulations and public laws in the procurement of contracts.

Section 16. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Sixty Thousand Bollars (869,000) from the General Fund to the Guam 19 Memorial Hospital Authority subject to the following conditions:

- The sum of \$50,000 is to be matched by \$15,000 from charitable contributions to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.
- The total sum of \$75,000 authorized and appropriated under this Section shall be used expressly for the purchase of optical equipment. It shall be unlawful to expend such funds for reasons other than the foregoing.

Section 17. The sum of Two Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$235,000) is horeby appropriated from the General Fund 30 % to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of purchasing packer trucks to be used under Solid Waste Division for its daily trash collection.

Section 18. A new Section 4026 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 4026. Each Board or Commission, the members of which are appointed by the Covernor, shall include representation of both sexes."
