AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER IV-A TO TITLE XII OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE PROVIDING FOR AUXILIARY SERVICES FOR THE BENEFIT OF CHILDREN ATTENDING NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Chapter IV-A is added to Title XII of the

Government Code to read:

"CHAPTER IV-A

Auxiliary Services

Section 11375. Definitions. As used in this Chapter:

(a) 'Auxiliary services' means:

(1) the supply for use by pupils attending nonpublic schools such standardized tests and scoring services as are in use in the public schools;

- (2) the provision of speech and hearing diagnostic services to pupils attending non-public school. Such services shall be provided in the nonpublic school attended by the pupil receiving the service;
- (3) the provision of diagnostic psychological services to pupils attending nonpublic schools. Such services shall be provided in the school attended by the pupil receiving the service;
- (4) the provision of therapeutic, psychological and speech and hearing services to pupils attending nonpublic schools. Such services shall be provided in a public school, in a public center or in mobile units located off of the nonpublic premises as determined by the Director of Education. If such services are provided in the public school or in public centers, transportation to and from such facilities shall be provided by the government;
- (5) the provision of guidance and counseling services to pupils attending nonpublic schools.

(6) the provision of remedial services
to pupils attending nonpublic schools. Such
services shall be provided in the public school,

- blind, emotionally disturbed, crippled and physically handicapped children attending nonpublic schools. Such services shall be provided in the public school or in public centers or in mobile units located off of the nonpublic premises as determined by the Director of Education. If such services are provided in the public school or in public centers, transportation to and from such facilities shall be provided by the government.
- (b) 'Nonpublic school' means a nonprofit school, other than a public school within the territory of Guam, wherein a resident of the territory may legally fulfill the compulsory school attendance requirements of this Title.

Section 11376. Program of Auxiliary Services.

Students attending nonpublic schools shall be furnished a program of auxiliary services if such services are available to pupils attending the public schools.

Such service shall be of the same quality as that provided public school pupils."
