AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 11320 THROUGH 11320.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE DETERMINATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SALARY LEVELS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. New Sections 11320 through 11320.3 are added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11320. Establishment of Incentive Salary for Administrative Positions. The Director shall submit to the Civil Service Commission for approval an incentive salary schedule for each classified administrative position within the Department of Education requiring teaching experience on the effective date of this Act. Placement on the salary schedule shall be in accordance with the duties and responsibilities of each position and the qualifications required for appointment to the position.

Section 11320.1. Administrative Salaries; Teaching Experience Required. The annual salary for positions for which appointment thereto requires teaching experience equals the sum of the following: (a) The annual salary which would result from
placement in the salary schedule set out at Section
4103 of this Code at the range and step for which the
appointee would be eligible if he were a teacher.

(b) An amount equal to twenty-five percentum (25%) of the amount payable under Subsection (a) of this Section.

(c) The incentive salary established pursuant to Section 11320 of this Code.

Section 11320.2 Administrative Salary; No Teaching Experience Required. The annual salary for a classified administrative position within the Department of Education which does not require teaching experience shall be established by the Director with approval of the Civil Service Commission. The salary shall be commensurate with those of other administrative positions within the Department of Education with consideration given to the duties and responsibilities of the position and the qualifications required.

Section 11320.3. The Director of Education shall adopt rules and regulations to provide for transfer of administrative personnel as is required for the most effective administration of the department and to provide for the welfare of the students. No person who is transferred from an administrative position in the department shall be eligible to pursue a grievance against the department if such transfer was in accord with the provisions of the rules and regulations promulgated in accordance with this section."

Section 2. Implementation. The salary schedule and 1 placement mechanism established by Sections 11320, 11320.1 and 2 11320.2 of the Government Code, as enacted by Section 1 of 3 this Act, shall take effect October 1, 1980; provided, however, 4 that if the Director and the Civil Service Commission fail to 5 complete the salary schedule required by Section 11320 until 6 after October 1, 1980, implementation of the schedule in 7 Section 1 of this Act shall be retroactive to October 1, 1980. 8 Beginning with fiscal year 1981, the annual cost for the 9 implementation of this Act shall be paid out of the annual 10 budgets of the Department of Education. 11
