




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE
RESTORATION OF THE MERIZO BELL TOWER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred
3 Dollars (\$37,500) is appropriated from the General Fund to Guam
4 Housing and Urban Renewal Authority for the restoration of
5 the Merizo Bell Tower. The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal
6 Authority shall provide an additional Thirty-Seven Thousand
7 Five Hundred Dollars (\$37,500) for the restoration project
8 out of its available funds. Restoration shall be completed
9 as expeditiously as possible. All bidding and specification
10 requirements established by statute, rule or regulation shall
11 not apply to the restoration project. The Guam Building Code
12 provisions and regulations as to construction shall not apply
13 to the restoration project.

1 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to
2 the Bureau of Environmental Health, Department of Public Health
3 and Social Services, the sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000),
4 as a supplement to the fiscal year 1980 budget, to be used as
5 follows:

6	a. for local travel	\$3,791
7	b. for office supplies	576
8	c. for overtime pay	1,633

9 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
