AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS NECESSARY FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE MERIZO BELL TOWER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$37,500) is appropriated from the General Fund to Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority for the restoration of the Merizo Bell Tower. The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority shall provide an additional Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$37,500) for the restoration project out of its available funds. Restoration shall be completed as expeditiously as possible. All bidding and specification requirements established by statute, rule or regulation shall not apply to the restoration project. The Guam Building Code provisions and regulations as to construction shall not apply to the restoration project.
