



Introduced by B. M. Palomo

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUCH SUMS NECESSARY FOR  
THE CONSTRUCTION OF FENCING FACILITIES FOR THE  
INARAJAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL FIELD AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to  
3 the Department of Public Works the sum of Five Thousand Dollars  
4 (\$5,000) for the construction of fencing facilities for the  
5 Inarajan Junior High School Baseball Field.

6 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund the  
7 sum of Two Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$275,000) to the  
8 Department of Education for the purpose of implementing Public  
9 Law 15-137, which provides for auxiliary services to students of  
10 non-public schools.

11 Section 3. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) is  
12 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
13 Public Works for ceiling repairs of the Guam Rehabilitation and  
14 Workshop Center. Any unencumbered balance from this appropriation  
15 shall revert to the General Fund by September 30, 1981.

16 Section 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to  
17 the Legislative Operations Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand  
18 Dollars (\$300,000), of which One Hundred Thousand Dollars  
19 (\$100,000) shall be allotted to the Minority Office, to provide  
20 for the operation expenses of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature. The  
21 appropriation made by this Section is an interim appropriation.  
22 The appropriation made by this Section may be used to meet obliga-  
23 tions incurred by the Fifteenth Guam Legislature for the Sixteenth  
24 Guam Legislature.

1 Section 5. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is  
2 appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Operations  
3 Fund for the purpose of conducting the Inauguration of the  
4 Sixteenth Guam Legislature. The Chairperson of the Committee on  
5 Rules of the Fifteenth Guam Legislature may authorize expenditure  
6 of funds from this appropriation prior to January 5, 1981.

7 Section 6. The sum of Six Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars  
8 (\$615,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legisla-  
9 tive Operations Fund for the operations of the Fifteenth Guam  
10 Legislature for the calendar year ending December 31, 1980. The  
11 sum appropriated by this Section is in addition to any other  
12 appropriations made to the Legislative Operations Fund. The  
13 appropriation shall be allocated by the Committee on Rules.

14 Section 7. Section 8982 of the Government Code is amended  
15 to read:

16 "Section 8982. Application for Bonuses. All applica-  
17 tions for bonuses authorized by this Chapter must be made to the  
18 Office of Veteran's Affairs on or before March 31, 1981. Each  
19 applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs  
20 evidence of his eligibility for a veteran's bonus. Eligibility  
21 may be evidenced by authenticated copies of records or certifi-  
22 cates issued by the Department of Defense, U. S. Military Service  
23 Department or any other authorized agency having such evidence  
24 in its possession."

25 Section 8. Subsection (b) of Section 8991 of the Government  
26 Code is amended to read:

27 "(b). All applications for the bonuses authorized by  
28 this Chapter must be made to the Director of Public Safety  
29 on or before March 31, 1981."

1 Section 9. The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is  
2 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
3 Agriculture to assist the Guam Farmers Union Association, the  
4 Guam Farmers Cooperative Association and the Malojloj/Inarajan  
5 Green Farm Association in marketing fresh produce.

6 Section 10. The sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000)  
7 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Insular Arts Council  
8 for the use and cash match of the Civic Center of Guam Foundation  
9 in the development of a conceptual program plan of the construc-  
10 tion of a cultural facility on Lot 87-5-1 in the municipality of  
11 Agana.

12 Section 11. (a) There is hereby appropriated from the  
13 General Fund the sum of Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000) to  
14 the Department of Youth Affairs for the purpose of defraying the  
15 expenses of Guam's participants in the Presidential Classroom  
16 for Young Americans Leadership Training Program for 1981.

17 (b) The Department of Youth Affairs shall set up administra-  
18 tive procedures to ensure equitable participants of all public  
19 and private high schools on Guam.

20 (c) This Act shall be effective upon enactment into law.

21 Section 12. One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,750)  
22 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public  
23 Health and Social Services, Communicable Disease Control Division,  
24 for the purchase of medication for indigent patients suffering  
25 from severe cases of tuberculosis.

26 Section 13. The sum of <sup>Forty Thousand Dollars 40,000</sup> ~~Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000)~~ is  
27 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
28 Education for the purpose of constructing and repairing bus  
29 shelters.

1 Section 14. The sum of ~~Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred~~

2 ~~Dollars (\$13,800)~~ is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
3 Public Defender Service Corporation to be used:

- 4 a) for local mileage reimbursement,  
5 not to exceed \$6,500
- 6 b) for off-island recruitment and  
7 termination, not to exceed 3,800
- 8 c) for lease of office space, not  
9 to exceed 3,500

10 Section 15. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) is  
11 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
12 Public Works for the purpose of upgrading the restroom facilities  
13 in the Sinajana Community Center.

14 Section 16. Section 29 of P. L. 15-129 is amended to read:

15 "Section 29. The sum of ~~One Hundred Twenty-Five Thou-~~  
16 ~~sand Dollars (\$125,000)~~ is appropriated from the General  
17 Fund to the Department of Public Safety for the purpose of  
18 purchasing a fire truck to be stationed at the Barrigada  
19 Fire Station. Notwithstanding provisions of law to the  
20 contrary, the Department may purchase a fire truck from a  
21 vendor which did not bid on it if the cost is significantly  
22 less."

23 Section 17. There is appropriated from the General Fund  
24 to the Guam Visitors Bureau the sum of ~~One Hundred Eighty-Three~~  
Dollars 100,000  
25 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$183,000)~~ to be used as follows:

- 26 Coronation Reimbursement \$60,000
- 27 Presidential Inauguration '81 13,000
- 28 North America Promotion Account 70,000
- 29 Community Development Account 40,000

1 Section 18. The sum of ~~Sixty Thousand Dollars~~ (\$60,000) is  
2 appropriated to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of  
3 renovating and extending the Barrigada Community Center.

4 Section 19. The sum of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand  
5 Dollars (\$125,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway  
6 Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resur-  
7 facing the Mesa & Fernandez Roads in the municipality of Yona and  
8 for the purpose of improving the drainage of Route 4 near the  
9 Ichihara's residence and the Mobile Gas Station near the entrance  
10 of the village of Yona.

11 Section 20. The sum of Fourteen Thousand Three Hundred  
12 Fourteen Dollars (\$14,314) is hereby appropriated from the General  
13 Fund to the Superior Court of Guam for the implementation of the  
14 salary reclassification of the Marshals' positions of the  
15 Superior Court of Guam.

16 Section 21. Section 4301.1 of the Government Code (enacted  
17 in Public Law 15-72) is amended to read:

18 "Section 4301.1. Non-Profit Organizations. The  
19 Director of Administration shall make unoccupied government-  
20 owned housing units available at no cost, under specified  
21 conditions to Chief Brodie School, the Department of Educa-  
22 tion, Department of Youth Affairs, Department of Vocational  
23 Rehabilitation, the Guam Advisory Council for Vocational  
24 Education and any non-profit organization engaged in the  
25 provision of such public services as crisis intervention,  
26 case work and counseling, or temporary residential care of  
27 minor children or abused spouses; provided that no such non-  
28 profit organization shall be eligible for such housing unless  
29 it shall have perfected its non-profit status with the  
30 Department of Revenue and Taxation and shall have been  
31 certified as qualifying by the Director of the Department of  
32 Public Health and Social Services."

1 Section 22. Section 4 of Public Law 15-121 is hereby  
2 amended to read:

3 "Section 4. The sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars  
4 (\$70,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to  
5 improve roads and drainage systems near the Truman Elemen-  
6 tary School in the municipality of Santa Rita."

7 Section 23. Section 34 of Public Law 15-129 is amended to  
8 read:

9 "Section 34. Until appropriate office space is  
10 available, the Guam Youth Building shall be used jointly by  
11 the Agana Village Commissioner, Commissioners Council and  
12 the Department of Parks and Recreation. Upon availability of  
13 appropriate office space, the Department of Parks and Recrea-  
14 tion shall vacate the Guam Youth Building and occupy  
15 designated office space. The Agana Village Commissioner  
16 shall then assume responsibility for the maintenance of the  
17 Guam Youth Building. However, the responsibility of  
18 maintenance shall continue with the Department of Parks and  
19 Recreation until such time as it vacates the Guam Youth  
20 Building."

21 Section 24. Section 5114 of the Government Code is amended  
22 to read:

23 "Section 5114. Department of Parks and Recreation.  
24 There is within the Executive Branch of the government of  
25 Guam a Department of Parks and Recreation. The Director of  
26 Parks and Recreation is the head of said department, and is  
27 appointed by the Parks and Recreation Commission pursuant  
28 to Section 20006(a) of this Code with the consent of the  
29 Governor and the Legislature."
