

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE UNIFORM COM-  
PENSATION FOR ALL BOARDS AND COMMISSION  
MEMBERS AT FIFTY DOLLARS PER MEETING, NOT  
TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The third paragraph of Section 54001 of the  
3 Government Code is amended to read:

4 "Members of the Board shall be compensated in the  
5 amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for attendance at each  
6 meeting, such compensation not to exceed One Hundred Dollars  
7 (\$100) per month."

8 Section 2. Section 19334 of the Government Code is amended  
9 to read:

10 "Section 19334. Same: compensation. Members of the  
11 Board shall be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per  
12 day for each day on which the Board meets, as certified  
13 by the Treasurer of Guam; such compensation shall not  
14 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month. The Secretary  
15 of the Board shall be paid an additional sum of Three  
16 Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) annually. The members of the  
17 Board are also entitled to compensation for their reasonable  
18 and necessary expenses incurred in the course of their  
19 official duties, as certified by the Treasurer."

1           Section 3. Subsection (d) of Section 30011 of the  
2 Government Code is amended to read:

3           "(d) Each member shall receive Fifty Dollars (\$50)  
4 a day as an honorarium for services, and in lieu of  
5 reimbursement for expenses incident to his duties, for each  
6 day or portion thereof spent in attending meetings of the  
7 Board. Such compensation shall not exceed One Hundred  
8 Dollars (\$100) per month."

9           Section 4. Subsection (d) is added to Section 10351 of the  
10 Government Code to read:

11           "(d) Compensation. Members of the Commission shall  
12 be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each  
13 day on which the Commission meets, such compensation shall  
14 not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

15           Section 5. Subsection (d) of Section 27202 of the  
16 Government Code is amended to read:

17           "(d) Compensation. Members of the Board shall receive  
18 compensation at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for  
19 attendance at each meeting, provided, however, that such  
20 compensation shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars  
21 (\$100) per month."

22           Section 6. Subsection (d) of IGCA Section 1651 is amended  
23 to read:

24           "(d) Commission members shall serve without compensa-  
25 tion except that each member shall be paid Fifty Dollars  
26 (\$50.00) for each day's attendance at a meeting of the  
27 Commission, provided, that such compensation is not to  
28 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month. Each member  
29 shall also be allowed actual expenses incurred in the  
30 discharge of his duties. Ex-officio members shall receive  
31 no compensation under this Section."

1 Section 7. Subsection (a) of Section 13501 of the Government  
2 Code (enacted in Public Law 13-74) is amended to read:

3 "(a) There is within the government of Guam the  
4 Chamorro Land Trust Commission. The Commission shall be  
5 composed of five (5) members to be appointed by the  
6 Governor with the confirmation of the Legislature.  
7 Commission members shall be appointed within sixty (60)  
8 days after the enactment of this Chapter. All members  
9 shall have been residents of the territory at least three  
10 (3) years prior to their appointment and at least three  
11 (3) of the members shall be native Chamorro. Members  
12 shall serve terms of three (3) years, provided, however,  
13 that of the members first appointed, one (1) shall be  
14 appointed for a term of one (1) year and two (2) shall be  
15 appointed for terms of two (2) years. The members of the  
16 Commission shall be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50)  
17 for each day's attendance at a meeting of the Commission,  
18 provided, however, that such compensation shall not exceed  
19 One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month. The Governor shall  
20 appoint the Chairman of the Commission from among the  
21 members thereof. The Commission shall have its first  
22 meeting within twenty (20) days after confirmation of its  
23 members."

24 Section 8. Section 1806.301(3) of the Civil Code is amended  
25 to read:

26 "(3) Members of the Council shall be paid at the  
27 rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day on which  
28 the Council meets, such remuneration not to exceed One  
29 Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

1           Section 9. Section 25404 of the Government Code is amended  
2 to read:

3           "Section 25404. Same: compensation. Every member of  
4 the Board who is not in the service of the government, for  
5 which he receives an annual compensation, shall be paid  
6 Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day on which the Board  
7 meets, provided, however, that such compensation shall not  
8 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

9           Section 10. Section 26201 of the Government Code (enacted  
10 in Public Law 13-80) is amended to read:

11           "Section 26201. Compensation and term. Commission  
12 members shall serve for a term of two (2) years, provided  
13 that of the members first appointed, three (3) shall serve  
14 for one (1) year and two (2) shall serve for two (2) years.  
15 Each member shall receive Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each day  
16 or portion thereof spent in attending meetings of the Board,  
17 such compensation shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars  
18 (\$100) per month."

19           Section 11. Subsection (b) of Section 13413 of the Govern-  
20 ment Code (enacted in Public Law 13-52) is amended to read:

21           "(b) Commission members shall serve without compensa-  
22 tion except that each member shall be paid a per diem of  
23 Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each day's attendance at a meeting  
24 of the Commission. Such remuneration shall not exceed  
25 One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

1           Section 12. Section 26101 of the Government Code is amended  
2 to read:

3           "Section 26101. Same: term and compensation. The  
4 members and chairman of the Board shall be appointed for  
5 terms of one (1) year each and shall receive compensation at  
6 the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each attendance at the  
7 meeting of the Board, provided, however, that no member  
8 shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
9 month."

10          Section 13. Section 27403 of the Government Code is amended  
11 to read:

12          "Section 27403. Board of Examiners for the practice  
13 of acupuncture; appointment; removal; qualifications.  
14 There shall be a board of examiners for the practice of  
15 acupuncture who shall be appointed by the Governor, subject  
16 to confirmation by the Legislature, in accordance with  
17 Section 27104 of the Government Code, whose duty it shall  
18 be to examine all applicants for license to practice  
19 acupuncture.

20          The board shall consist of five (5) persons: one (1)  
21 shall be a physician or surgeon licensed under the laws  
22 of the territory, one (1) shall be a licensed practitioner  
23 of acupuncture, one (1) shall be a member of the legal  
24 profession, one (1) shall be the Director of Public Health  
25 and Social Services, and one (1) an individual who is not  
26 a licensed physician, practitioner of acupuncture, or  
27 attorney but who is a resident in good standing of the  
28 territory of Guam. However, the initial board of examiners

1 shall consist of three (3) members: one (1) shall be a  
2 member of the legal profession, one (1) the Director of  
3 Department of Public Health and Social Services, and one (1)  
4 a resident in good standing of the territory of Guam. Each  
5 member of the board who is not in the service of the  
6 government, for which he receives an annual compensation,  
7 shall be paid Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day  
8 on which the board meets, provided, however, that such  
9 compensation shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100)  
10 per month. A majority of the board shall constitute a  
11 quorum."

12 Section 14. Subsection (d) is added to Section 62012 of  
13 the Government Code to read:

14 "(d) Each member of the Council shall be paid Fifty  
15 Dollars (\$50) per day for each day on which the Council  
16 meets, provided, however, that such compensation shall not  
17 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

18 Section 15. Subsection (a) of Section 49253.3 of the  
19 Government Code (enacted in Public Law 14-11) is amended to read:

20 "(a) Selection of Officers; Compensation of Members.  
21 The Governor or his representative shall serve as temporary  
22 chairman and shall convene the first meeting of the  
23 Commission. At its first meeting, the Commission shall  
24 select a chairman and such other officers from its membership  
25 as it deems necessary. The Commission may meet as often  
26 as is necessary upon call of the chairman but meetings  
27 shall be held at least quarterly. Every member of the  
28 Commission who is not in the service of the government,

1 for which he receives an annual compensation, shall be paid  
2 Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day on which the board  
3 meets, provided, however, that such compensation shall not  
4 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

5 Section 16. Subsection (a) of Section 16407 of the  
6 Government Code is amended to read:

7 "(a) Members of the Board of Cosmetology shall be  
8 paid such amount as shall be approved by the Board, not in  
9 excess of Fifty Dollars (\$50) a day, for each day on which  
10 meetings are held by the Board. Such compensation is not  
11 to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

12 Section 17. A new Section 11950.1 is added to the Govern-  
13 ment Code to read:

14 "Section 11950.1. Compensation of Commission. Members  
15 of the Commission shall be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars  
16 (\$50) per day for each day on which the Commission meets,  
17 such compensation not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100)  
18 per month."

19 Section 18. A new Section 26301.1 is added to the Govern-  
20 ment Code to read:

21 "Section 26301.1. Compensation of Council. Every  
22 member of the Council shall receive compensation at the  
23 rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each attendance at the  
24 meeting of the Council, provided, however, that no members  
25 shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
26 month."

27 Section 19. Section 47005 of the Government Code is amended  
28 to read:

29 "Section 47005. Board compensation. Members of the  
30 Board shall receive compensation at the rate of Fifty Dollars  
31 (\$50) for each attendance at the meeting of the Board,  
32 provided, however, that no member shall receive more than  
33 One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."



1           Section 20. Subsection (e) of Section 21001 of the Govern-  
2 ment Code (enacted in Public Law 13-179) is amended to read:

3           "(e) Each of the members shall receive compensation  
4 at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day for each  
5 day's attendance at a meeting of the Commission, provided,  
6 however, that such compensation shall not exceed One  
7 Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month, and such reasonable  
8 traveling expenses as may be incurred in the discharge of  
9 their duties."

10          Section 21. Subsection (a) is added to Section 9990.2 of  
11 the Government Code to read:

12          "(a) Compensation of members. Members of the Commis-  
13 sion shall be paid at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per  
14 day for each day on which the Commission meets, such  
15 compensation not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
16 month."

17          Section 22. Subsection (d) of Section 61009 of the Govern-  
18 ment Code (enacted in Public Law 13-93) is amended to read:

19          "(d) The Board members shall receive no salary for  
20 their services on the Board, provided, however, that they  
21 may be paid a reasonable per diem not to exceed Fifty  
22 Dollars (\$50) for attendance at meetings of the Board and  
23 reasonable travel allowance for time spent on official  
24 business of the Corporation, except that the Station Manager  
25 shall not be paid any sums under this clause."

1 Section 23. Section 26005 of the Government Code is amended  
2 to read:

3 "Section 26005. Same: Composition: Compensation:  
4 Meetings. The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members,  
5 two (2) of whom shall be youth members in their first terms  
6 on the Board who are between the ages of eighteen (18) and  
7 twenty-two (22), when appointed, who shall be appointed by  
8 the Governor with the consent of the Legislature. The  
9 Governor shall appoint Commission members within thirty (30)  
10 days of the effective date of this section. Members shall  
11 serve for four (4) years, provided that of the members first  
12 appointed three (3), including one (1) youth member, shall  
13 serve for two (2) years. Commission members shall be paid  
14 at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day  
15 on which the Commission meets, such compensation not to  
16 exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month. Commission  
17 meetings shall be public."

18 Section 24. Section 27104 of the Government Code is amended  
19 by adding the following paragraph to read:

20 "The members of each Board of Examiners shall be paid  
21 Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day for each day on which meetings  
22 are held by the respective boards. No member shall receive  
23 more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."

24 Section 25. Section 58055 of the Government Code (amended  
25 by Public Law 13-162) is amended to read:

26 "Section 58055. Compensation and Expenses. Each  
27 member of the Commission, except the Commissioner, shall  
28 receive compensation at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per  
29 day for each day on which the Commission meets, such  
30 compensation not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
31 month."

1 Section 26. Subsection (d) is added to Section 10502 of  
2 the Government Code (enacted in Public Law 14-51) to read:

3 "(d) Compensation. Members of the Board shall receive  
4 the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each attendance at the  
5 meeting of the Board, provided, however, that no member  
6 shall receive more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
7 month."

8 Section 27. Subsection (d) of Section 11990.3 of the  
9 Government Code (enacted in Public Law 13-18) is amended to read:

10 "(d) Board members shall serve without compensation  
11 except that each member shall be paid a per diem of Fifty  
12 Dollars (\$50.00) for each day of attendance at a meeting  
13 of the Board, such compensation not to exceed One Hundred  
14 Dollars (\$100.00) per month. Each member shall also be  
15 allowed actual expenses incurred in the discharge of his  
16 duties."

17 Section 28. Section 21949 of the Government Code, as  
18 amended in Public Law 15-92, is further amended to read:

19 "Section 21949. Composition of Board. The Board shall  
20 consist of five (5) directors appointed by the Governor  
21 with the advice and consent of the Legislature. The Governor  
22 will designate, from among the members of the Board thus  
23 appointed, the president and vice-president of the Authority.  
24 The Directors and officers thus appointed and designated  
25 shall hold office for terms of three (3) years unless  
26 sooner removed by the Governor and shall be paid at the  
27 rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) per day, for each day on which  
28 the Board meets, provided, however, that such compensation  
29 shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month; and  
30 they may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in  
31 carrying out their responsibilities."

1           Section 29. The second paragraph of Section 26504 of the  
2 Government Code (enacted in Public Law 14-110) is amended to  
3 read:

4           "The Council shall elect from among its members a  
5 Chairman and a Vice Chairman. Six (6) members shall  
6 constitute a quorum. The affirmative votes of six (6)  
7 members shall be necessary for Council action. Members of  
8 the Council shall be compensated at the rate of Fifty Dollars  
9 (\$50) per day for each day on which the Council meets, such  
10 compensation not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per  
11 month."

12           Section 30. The second paragraph of Section 9984 of the  
13 Government Code (enacted in Public Law 14-139) is amended to  
14 read:

15           "At its initial meeting, the Council members shall  
16 elect from among its ranks a Chairman and Vice Chairman.  
17 Six (6) members of the Council shall constitute a quorum.  
18 The affirmative votes of eight (8) members shall be necessary  
19 for Council action. Of the initial appointments, five (5)  
20 members of the Council shall serve for one (1) year, five  
21 (5) members shall serve for a period of three (3) years and  
22 five (5) members shall serve for a period of two (2) years.  
23 At the expiration of these terms, all members shall be  
24 appointed for three (3) year periods. Members of the Council  
25 shall serve until their successors are appointed and  
26 qualified. Members of the Council shall be paid at the  
27 rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50) for each day's attendance at a  
28 meeting of the Council, provided, however, that such  
29 compensation shall not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100)  
30 per month."

1 Section 31. Section 1304 of 1GCA is amended to read:

2 "Section 1304. Compensation of the Commission. The  
3 members of the Commission shall be compensated Fifty Dollars  
4 (\$50) for each meeting they attend not to exceed two (2)  
5 meetings per month. The members shall be reimbursed for  
6 reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the perfor-  
7 mance of their duties as certified by the Chairman, but in  
8 no event to exceed the established per diem rates of the  
9 government."

10 Section 32. A new Chapter XIII is added to Title VII of  
11 the Government Code to read:

12 "Section 6911. Uniform per diem for Boards and  
13 Commissions. A member of a board or commission shall be  
14 compensated in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for  
15 attending a board or commission meeting, such compensation  
16 not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month."
