




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT AMENDING THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
RELATIVE TO RESIDENT TUITION FOR TRUST
TERRITORY STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM.

1 WHEREAS, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands is under
2 the Trusteeship of the United States; and

3 WHEREAS, the Trusteeship is scheduled to terminate in 1981;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the integrity of the United States in the adminis-
6 tration of her Trusteeship has frequently been questioned by
7 various elements; and

8 WHEREAS, status negotiations are continuing between the
9 United States and the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; and

10 WHEREAS, the United States demonstrates good faith by
11 offering continued economic assistance to the Trust Territory
12 for a period following termination of the Trusteeship Agreement;

1 WHEREAS, Guam, as the westernmost outpost of the United
2 States, has an important role in demonstrating the sincerity of
3 the United States towards the Trust Territory; and

4 WHEREAS, the people of Guam have always welcomed students
5 from the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; now, therefore,

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

7 Section 1. Section 11832.1 of the Government Code (Public
8 Law 14-132) is amended to read:

9 "Section 11832.1. Students who are residents of the
10 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and those
11 islands currently denominated the Trust Territory of the
12 Pacific Islands who come to Guam to matriculate at the
13 University of Guam shall be charged resident tuition for
14 their attendance at the University of Guam."
