AN ACT AMENDING THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO RESIDENT TUITION FOR TRUST TERRITORY STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM.

WHEREAS, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands is under the Trusteeship of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Trusteeship is scheduled to terminate in 1981; and

WHEREAS, the integrity of the United States in the administration of her Trusteeship has frequently been questioned by various elements; and

WHEREAS, status negotiations are continuing between the United States and the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; and

WHEREAS, the United States demonstrates good faith by offering continued economic assistance to the Trust Territory for a period following termination of the Trusteeship Agreement;

WHEREAS, Guam, as the westernmost outpost of the United States, has an important role in demonstrating the sincerity of the United States towards the Trust Territory; and

WHEREAS, the people of Guam have always welcomed students from the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11832.1 of the Government Code (Public Law 14-132) is amended to read:

"Section 11832.1. Students who are residents of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and those islands currently denominated the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands who come to Guam to matriculate at the University of Guam shall be charged resident tuition for their attendance at the University of Guam."
