


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (f)
TO SECTION 5155 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE TO REQUIRE ALL TERRITORIAL
AGENCIES TO ESTABLISH THE PRIORITY
OF IMPORTANCE OF EACH ITEM WITHIN
ITS ANNUAL BUDGET AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Subsection (f) is added to Section 5155
3 of the Government Code to read:

4 "(f) Each territorial agency shall send a representa-
5 tive or representatives to the legislative hearing or
6 hearings dealing with that part of the annual Executive
7 Budget dealing with such agency. At least four (4) days
8 prior to said hearing, each agency shall submit to the
9 Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means a statement
10 indicating the priority of each program contemplated within
11 the proposed budget which will be the subject of such hearing
12 or hearings. Such prioritization shall be set out in such
13 a manner that the Legislature may decide, from necessity
14 or objective determination of the inappropriateness of any
15 program to eliminate or reduce the portion of the proposed
16 budget related to that program."

1 Section 2. Subsection II. A. 1., 3., and 4., Part Two of
2 Public Law 14-132 are amended to read as follows:
