AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (f) TO SECTION 5155 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO REQUIRE ALL TERRITORIAL AGENCIES TO ESTABLISH THE PRIORITY OF IMPORTANCE OF EACH ITEM WITHIN ITS ANNUAL BUDGET AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (f) is added to Section 5155

of the Government Code to read:

"(f) Each territorial agency shall send a representative or representatives to the legislative hearing or hearings dealing with that part of the annual Executive Budget dealing with such agency. At least four (4) days prior to said hearing, each agency shall submit to the Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means a statement indicating the priority of each program contemplated within the proposed budget which will be the subject of such hearing or hearings. Such prioritization shall be set out in such a manner that the Legislature may decide, from necessity or objective determination of the inappropriateness of any program to eliminate or reduce the portion of the proposed budget related to that program."
