




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER III TO TITLE XXXVI
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO ESTABLISH A GRAND
PRIX RACING COMMISSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter III is added to Title XXXVII of
3 the Government Code to read:

4 "CHAPTER III

5 Grand Prix Racing Commission

6 Section 26300. There is within the government of
7 Guam a Grand Prix Racing Commission.

8 Section 26301. The Grand Prix Racing Commission shall
9 consist of seven (7) members, all residents of Guam who
10 shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and
11 consent of the Legislature, from the following groups: Two
12 (2) members representing motorcycle clubs; two (2) members
13 from automobile clubs; one (1) member from the Parks and
14 Recreation Department; and two (2) members from among the
15 general public of Guam. There may be an additional
16 advisors who shall be without vote. Advisory members shall
17 be appointed and served at the pleasure of the Commission.

18 Section 26302. Same: chairman. The chairman shall
19 be elected by a majority vote of the members of the Commis-
20 sion.

1 Section 26303. Same: meetings. Meetings of the
2 Commission shall be open and held at a regular time and
3 place each month. Special meetings may be called by the
4 chairman and, at his discretion, shall be opened or closed.

5 Section 26304. Same: tenure. The members of the
6 Commission shall serve for three (3) years; provided, that
7 of the members first appointed, two (2) shall serve for
8 one (1) year and two (2) shall serve for two (2) years.

9 Section 26305. Same: acts. The concurrence of four
10 (4) members of the Commission shall be necessary to the
11 validity of any of its acts.

12 Section 26306. Same: compensation. Members of the
13 Commission shall serve without pay but shall be reimbursed
14 for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the per-
15 formance of their duties as certified by the Treasurer of
16 Guam.

17 Section 26307. Same: rules and regulations. The
18 Commission shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations, not
19 inconsistent with the laws of the United States and this
20 territory (a) for its own government and (b) for the purpose
21 of carrying out all other duties, powers and responsibilities
22 herein conferred.

23 Section 26308. Same: publication. All rules and
24 regulations adopted by the Commission pursuant to this Title
25 shall be published and distributed.

26 Section 26309. Purpose. The purpose of the Grand
27 Prix Racing Commission is to bring about Grand Prix road
28 racing within the territory of Guam. In pursuance of this
29 purpose, the Commission shall conduct such studies as are
30 necessary in order to formulate a plan which would result
31 in Grand Prix Racing. In accordance with such plan, the
32 Commission shall request necessary appropriations and
33 legislation to implement such plan."
