


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





Introduced by F. F. Blas

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A STUDY AND BASIC DESIGN
FOR AN AQUARIUM PROJECT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the Tourist Attrac-
3 tion Fund the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) to the
4 University of Guam to fund the necessary studies for the construc-
5 tion of an aquarium.

6 Section 2. Section 9 of Part Five of Public Law 14-132 is
7 amended to read:

8 "Section 9. The appropriations made by Sections 6, 7
9 and 8 of Part Five of this Act shall be effective October 1,
10 1978 through September 30, 1979, or on the date specified in
11 the official award letters from the Grantor Agencies."

12 Section 3. The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is
13 appropriated from the General Fund to the Micronesian Area
14 Research Center of the University of Guam for the purpose of
15 obtaining copies of documents of the correspondence of Secretary
16 of the Navy at the National Archives in Washington, D. C. These
17 documents serve as the foundation for the annual reports written
18 during the American Naval Government period of Guam.
