




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 308, "An Act to appropriate money from the General Fund to the Guam Law Revision Commission for calendar year 1979" returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 4th day of June 1979, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 17 members.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FROM THE  
GENERAL FUND TO THE GUAM LAW REVISION  
COMMISSION FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1979.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 25 of Public Law 14-140 is hereby  
3 repealed and reenacted to read:

4 "Section 9. The sum of Two Hundred Twenty-Three  
5 Thousand One Hundred Seven Dollars (\$223,107) is appro-  
6 priated from the General Fund to the Guam Law Revision  
7 Commission for calendar years 1978 and 1979."

8 Section 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
