AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION 6120 TO TITLE VII, CHAPTER II OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO NEGOTIATE A LINE OF CREDIT WITH ANY REGISTERED BANK ON GUAM THAT ACTS AS A DEPOSITORY OF GOVERNMENT MONIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 6120 is hereby added to Title VII, Chapter II of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 6120. The Governor, on behalf of the government of Guam, is authorized to arrange a line of credit not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) with any bank or commercial lending institutions licensed on Guam. The terms of the line of credit shall include the following:

(a) The line of credit shall be used by the Governor in cases where a cash shortage is eminent and a strong likelihood exists that the shortage could hamper governmental operations.

(b) Prepaid charges shall not be levied by the bank or trust department for opening the line of credit.

- (c) The interest rate shall be subject to negotiation between the Governor and the bank. In no case, however, shall the interest rate exceed nine percentum (9%) per annum. Such interest rate shall be computed on a monthly average and based on the actual amounts extended to the government.
- (d) Interest derived from the line of credit shall be exempt from taxation by the government of Guam.
- (e) All terms of the line of credit agreement not specifically defined in the foregoing shall be negotiated by the Governor in the best interest of the people of Guam.
- (f) Any amount borrowed shall be repaid within one (1) year. Funds necessary for such repayment of interest and principal are appropriated from the General Fund. In no case shall any amount borrowed be refinanced permitting repayment more than one (1) year after the loan is made. If any amount borrowed cannot be repaid within one (1) year, the provisions of this section shall be suspended until all amounts borrowed under the line of credit are repaid."

Section 2. (a) The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of paying a portion of the purchase price of the Medical Center of the Marianas.

(b) The Governor, on behalf of the government of Guam, is authorized to borrow from any commercial lending institution the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) upon such terms and conditions as are in the best interest of the people of Guam, but in no event shall this interest exceed nine percentum (9%) per annum. Interest earned by the lending institution shall be exempt from taxation by the government of Guam. The proceeds of the loan shall be used to pay the portion owed by the government of Guam for the purchase price of the Medical Center of the Marianas. Such funds as are necessary are appropriated from the General Fund for repayment of the loan authorized by this section.

Section 3. Section 1, paragraph (4) of P. L. 14-91 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. The Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to borrow not to exceed Thirty Million Bollars (\$30,000,000) for the purpose of implementing Capital Improvement Highway and/or Mass Transit Projects provided, however, that the terms and conditions of the loan shall be approved by the Legislature.

Section 5. Except such sums as are necessary to pay for the adequate maintenance and upkeep of the streets, roads and highways in the territory, all revenues deposited in the Territorial Righway Fund for the purpose of implementing Capital Improvement Righway and/or Mass Transit Projects may be used to guarantee the repayments of the loan agreement made under Section 4 of this Act. All Capital Improvement Highway and/or Mass Transit Projects to be funded from the provisions of this Act must be reviewed pursuant to P. L. 11-82 and approved by the Governor prior to their implementation.

Section 6. The Director of the Department of Public Works is required to submit to the Legislature, at least once each fiscal year, a status report of the highway and or mass transit projects approved under the provisions of Sections 4 and 5 of this Act. This status report shall include:

- (A) Project Description
- (B) Project Location
- (C) Project Costs

- (D) Sources of Funding
- (E) Status of the Project

Section 7. The Department of Administration, Department of Public Works and the Bureau of Budget and Management Research are hereby directed to initiate whatever steps are necessary to implement the intent and provisions of Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 of this Act.
