AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 11101(a) AND (b) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1, Subsections 11101(a) and (b) of the Government Code are amended to read:

"Section 11101. Administration of Department of Education. The Department of Education shall be under the general cognizance of the Governor and shall be administered through:

(a) The Territorial Board of Education which shall be the governing and policy determining body of the department.

(b) The Director of Education who is the Executive Secretary of the Board of Education is vested with all executive and administrative functions of the Department of Education. The authority and responsibility of the Director include the following:

(1) to see that all rules and regulations of the department are enforced;

(2) to attend all meetings of the Board and submit a general report of the affairs of the department;

(3) to keep the Board advised as to the needs of the department;

(4) to devote his or her entire time to the business of the department, to select and appoint the employees of the department except as otherwise provided by law and to plan, organize, coordinate and control the services of such employees in the exercise of the power of the department under the general direction of the Board; and
