




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE ONE (1) FROM
ROUTE SIXTEEN (16) TO Y-SENG SONG ROAD.

1 WHEREAS, there has been significant increases in the popula-
2 tion of the northern area of Guam with the advent of cluster
3 housing developments; and

4 WHEREAS, the density of the northern half of the island now
5 approaches 685 persons per square mile, slightly higher than the
6 densely settled countries in Asia and Europe; and

7 WHEREAS, it is estimated that the island's population will
8 double by the year 2000; and

9 WHEREAS, an increase in commercial activity has and will
10 continue to accompany a population increase in the north; and

11 WHEREAS, approximately fifty-one percent (51%) of Route 1
12 between Route 16 and Y-Seng Song is composed of two (2) lanes,
13 which poses problems during peak hours; and

1 WHEREAS, vehicles are the only means of transportation on
2 Guam and can be considered a necessity; and

3 WHEREAS, further housing development in the north would
4 compound the existing traffic congestion along Route 1 in
5 Dededo; and

6 WHEREAS, during a two (2) year period (1976-1977), there were
7 1,155 accidents in Dededo and Yigo, indicating a growing need for
8 highways and requirements for highway safety; now, therefore,

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
11 balance of the Territorial Highway Fund the sum of Three Million
12 Nine Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$3,970,000) to include
13 Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) grants in the amount of Two
14 Million Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$2,740,000) for the
15 construction of a highway capital improvement within the limits
16 specified herein:

22 Section 2. This project includes the signalization at five
23 (5) intersections along the project limits and construction of a
24 frontage road approximately 1,000 feet in length connecting
25 Harmon Loop Road and an access easement running perpendicular
26 to Route 1.

27 Section 3. The appropriation made in Section 1 and the
28 authorization for local funds use shall expire on December 31,
29 1980.
