AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 15007 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO ALLOW THE GOVERNOR TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 15007 of the
Government Code is amended to read:

"(b) If, by reason of death, resignation, removal from office, inability or failure, there is a vacancy in the Office of the Commissioner of a municipality or village for which there is an Assistant Commissioner, then the Assistant Commissioner shall, upon his resignation as an Assistant Commissioner, act as Commissioner. vacancy in the Office of Commissioner of a municipality or village for which there is no Assistant Commissioner shall be filled for the unexpired term by the Governor who shall appoint the person chosen by the Municipal Planning Council of a municipality or village with the advice and consent of the Legislature. If, by reason of inability due to illness or travel off-island, there is a temporary vacancy of greater than one week in the Office of Commissioner of a municipality for which there is no Assistant Commissioner, the temporary vacancy shall be filled by the Governor's appointment of an Acting Commissioner."

Section 2. A new Section 5000 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 5000. Temporary vacancies, order of succession.

- (a) The order of succession, consisting of the officers who shall be eligible in the order named to serve as Acting Governor upon the temporary disability or temporary absence of both the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor shall be the Speaker or Acting Speaker of the Guam Legislature. While serving as Acting Governor, a person so authorized shall have all the powers of the Governor.
- (b) The order of succession, consisting of the officers who shall be eligible in the order named, to serve as Acting Lieutenant Governor upon the temporary disability or temporary absence of the Governor or the Lieutenant Governor and the Speaker of the Guam Legislature, shall be the Vice Speaker or the Acting Speaker. While serving as Acting Lieutenant Governor a person so authorized shall have all the powers of the Lieutenant Governor."

Section 3. Notwithstanding the provision of any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of establishing an 'Emergency Farm and Fishery Financial Assistance Grant Funds' to assist the island farm and fishery operators. Provided, however, that the sum of \$20,000 of the sum herein appropriated shall be allocated to subsidize the importation of fresh water prawn larvae. Any funds not expended prior to March 1, 1980 shall revert to the General Fund.

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Section 4. The Director of the Department of Agriculture shall be responsible for the administration of the 'Emergency Farm and Fishery Financial Assistance Grant Funds' and shall promulgate such rules and regulations necessary to meet the intent of the grant in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Act.

Section 5. Section 19571.02 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"02. A tax at the rate of six cents (\$0.06) per gallon on all other liquid fuel as defined herein except liquid fuel used for commercial aviation purposes which is taxed at a rate of four cents (\$0.04) per gallon."

Section 6. Section 19572.02 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"02. On liquid fuel purchased solely for marine purposes and not used on the public roads on Guam, a drawback of one cent (\$0.01) per gallon on diesel fuel and two cents (\$0.02) per gallon on all other liquid fuels."
