




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT ADDING SECTION 25301.1 TO CHAPTER
IV, TITLE XXVI OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
RELATIVE TO REQUIRING AN ON-SALE LICENSEE
TO POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN THE
INTERIOR OF THE PREMISES A PRICE LIST OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SOLD OR OFFERED FOR
SALE AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF 1.3
MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE RESURFACING OF
INARAJAN-MERIZO (ROUTE 4) ROAD AND VILLAGE
ROADS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INARAJAN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 25301.1 is added to Chapter IV,
3 Title XXVI of the Government Code to read:

4 "Section 25301.1. An on-sale licensee shall post in
5 a conspicuous place in the premises a current price list
6 of alcoholic beverages, beers, and all other beverages sold
7 or offered for sale within the premises."

8 Section 2. The sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars
9 (\$600,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to
10 the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resurfacing
11 village streets in the municipality of Inarajan.

12 Section 3. The sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$700,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to
14 the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resurfacing
15 the Inarajan-Merizo (Route 4) road from the south entrance of
16 the Inarajan village proper to approximately 1400 feet past the
17 Inarajan Agafayan Bridge.

1 Section 4. Section 25331 of Title XXVI of the Government
2 Code is amended to read:

3 "Section 25331. Size of measuring glass or use of
4 measuring instrument for mixing drinks prescribed.

5 General on-sale licensees shall use a full one (1) ounce
6 measuring glass, or shall use an electronic measuring
7 device approved by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board,
8 when mixing drinks at the bar."

9 Section 5. This Act shall become effective upon enactment
10 into law.

11 Section 6. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to
12 the contrary, the ^{One Hundred Eighteen Thousand \$118,000} ~~Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000)~~ in
13 lapsed funds from the transitional quarter appropriation in
14 Public Law 15-48 are re-appropriated for Fiscal Year 1980 to the
15 Department of Education:

16 a. For employment of teachers to
17 meet increased enrollment \$50,000.00

18 b. For off-island travel for
19 students and chaperons to
20 participate in the Presidential
21 Classroom for Young Americans
22 and for other sports activities
23 within the Department of
24 Education \$12,500.00

25 c. For the tiling of Agana Heights
26 Elementary School floors ⁻⁰⁻ ~~\$20,000.00~~ *DB*

27 d. For preparation of new athletic
28 field at Ulloa Elementary
29 School ⁻⁰⁻ ~~\$32,000.00~~ *DB*

30 e. For engineering services for
31 athletic fields at John F.

18 Section 7. There is appropriated from the General Fund the
19 sum of Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) to Department of
20 Public Works for the purpose of installing asphalt pavement on
21 the road leading to the Jose U. Atoigue Baseball Park from
22 Chelenko Road and the parking lot at said park in Chalan Pago.

23 Section 8. Part One, Section 1, Subsection VII.A.2. of
24 Public Law 15-66 is amended to read:

- 25 "VII. COMMUNITY SERVICES
- 26 A. Department of Public Health and Social
27 Services
- 28 2. Division of Senior Citizens,
29 not to exceed \$346,057".

30 Section 9. Part Two, Section 1, Subsection VII.A.1. of
31 Public Law 15-66 is repealed and reenacted to read:
