AN ACT ADDING SECTION 25301.1 TO CHAPTER IV, TITLE XXVI OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO REQUIRING AN ON-SALE LICENSEE TO POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN THE INTERIOR OF THE PREMISES A PRICE LIST OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE AND TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF 1.3 MILLION DOLLARS FOR THE RESURFACING OF INARAJAN-MERIZO (ROUTE 4) ROAD AND VILLAGE ROADS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF INARAJAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 25301.1 is added to Chapter IV, Title XXVI of the Government Code to read:

"Section 25301.1. An on-sale licensee shall post in a conspicuous place in the premises a current price list of alcoholic beverages, beers, and all other beverages sold or offered for sale within the premises."

Section 2. The sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resurfacing village streets in the municipality of Inarajan.

Section 3. The sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Bollars (\$700,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resurfacing the Inarajan-Merizo (Route 4) road from the south entrance of the Inarajan village proper to approximately 1400 feet past the Inarajan Agafayan Bridge.

1 Section 4. Section 25331 of Title XXVI of the Government 2 Code is amended to read: 3 "Section 25331.
