AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6610.5 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO CHANGE THE MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FROM TWENTY CENTS (20¢) TO THIRTY CENTS (30¢) FOR ALL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PHOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 6610.5 of the Government Code (as amended in Public Law 14-119) is amended to read:

"Section 6610.5. Mileage allowance. Persons authorized to travel at government expense shall, in accordance with regulations and whenever such mode of transportation is authorized or approved as more advantageous to the government, be paid in lieu of transportation not to exceed thirty cents (30¢) per mile for the use of privately owned four-wheeled passenger motor vehicles or ten cents (10¢) per mile for the use of other types of privately owned vehicles, when engaged on official business within or outside their designated posts of duty. In addition to the mileage allowance, there may be allowed reimbursement for the actual cost of ferry fares and bridge, road and tunnel fares."
