AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 GCA 416 RELATIVE TO THE GUAM HYMN AND THE GUAM MARCH OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 1 GCA 416 is amended to read:

"Section 416. Guam Hymn and Guam March. The composition consisting of the words and music known as the 'Guam Hymn', composed by Dr. Ramon M. Sablan, is designated the territorial hymn and the composition of music known as the 'Guam March', composed by Jose Martinez Torres, is designated the territorial march of the territory of Guam. The Guam Hymn shall be played immediately after the playing of the national anthem of the United States of America at the commencement of all official ceremonies conducted by the government of Guam. The Guam March shall be played optionally."
