AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, THE TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAM AND THE NURSES TRAINING PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of One Million Three Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Two Dellars (\$1,355,362) to the Student Financial Assistance Fund established under Section 11802 of the Government Code and administered by the Board of Regents of the University of Guam. The appropriation shall be expended as follows:

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 11802 of the Government Code, the appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act shall supplement the unexpended balance of Ninety Three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Nine Dollars (\$93,529) in the Student Financial Assistance Fund including funds received for repayment.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars (\$350,55%) to the University of Guam for the Teacher

Training Scholarship Program and the Nurses Training Program at the University of Guam, to be expended as follows:

- (a) Teacher Training Scholarship Program \$ 339,558
- (b) Nurses Training Program \$ 11,000.

Section 4. The appropriations made in this Act shall be expended during the period commencing August 1, 1982 and ending July 31, 1983 and shall not be subject to any allotment reserve that could be imposed by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research.

Section 5. Subsection (d) of Section 12 of Public Law 16-91 is repealed and reenacted to read:

"(d) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) is apprepriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund for the resurfacing and improvement of the multi-purpose courts in Merizo and Sinajana; for improvements at the Agana Paseo grounds; and for improvements on the Toto multi-purpose court and youth center. The appropriation made in this subsection shall be expended upon approval of the Department of Parks and Recreation."
