AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR TO LEASE A CERTAIN GOVERNMENT OF GUAM LAND AND BUILDING TO THE GUAM FARMERS COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to lease to the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association the following tract of government-owned land and building:

- A. Lot Nos. 1361-1-B-R1 (2,122.7±sq.m.) and 1361-1-C New (4,214.9±sq.m.), municipality of Agana, containing an area of 6,337.1 square meters, less 29' of the western portion now occupied by Singer Sewing Machine Company (Lot 1393-1, CT. 16754).
- B. Semi-concrete building, approximately 40' x 80' dimension (formerly Farmers Public Market).

The Governor shall execute all instruments necessary to carry out the provisions of Sections 1 thru 5 of this Act. The provisions of Section 3 of P.L. 12-61, as amended, shall not apply to the land lease authorized in this section.

Section 2. The government shall lease to the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per annum the lots and building cited in Section 1. The Association may subject the property and its improvements to a leasehold mortgage.

Section 3. The land leased to the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association shall be for a period of fifty (50) years. Upon the expiration of the said fifty (50) years, the lease shall be subject to renegotiation between the government of Guam and the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association.

Section 4. The land leased shall be for the purpose of a chill and freezer facilities, dry storage, retail and wholesale transactions and headquarters of the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association with adjacent parking facilities.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any other laws to the contrary, the lease by the government to the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association of Lots 1361-1-B-R1 and 1361-1-C New, Agana, and improvements thereon, shall be valid upon execution by the Governor and the duly authorized representative of the Guam Farmers Cooperative Association. The lease shall not require the concurrence of the Legislature.

Section 6. The Compiler of Laws is directed to codify
Sections 1 through 5 of this Act as part of the codes of Guam.
