AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$295,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT AN ACCESS ROAD TO PAGO BAY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Public Law 16-36 appropriated Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) for the acquisition of the required land area for an access road leading to Pago Bay from Inalado Road; and

WHEREAS, necessary transaction for land acquisition has been completed and it is now in the best interest of the people of Guam particularly those who are residing in areas close to Pago Bay to be provided access to the beach site and other appropriate recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the improvements envisioned in this area will greatly enhance the recreational programs for the residents as well as for Guam's visitors; now, therefore.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is hereby appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to

the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing a public road to Pago Bay and beach area from the Inaldo Road with necessary street lighting facilities.

Section 2. The sum of One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Dollars (\$185,000) is hereby appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing a pavilion of at least 2,000 square feet at Pago Bay with adequate toilet and shower facilities.

Section 3. The sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) is hereby appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing a boat launching ramp and required dredging at Pago Bay and Old Agat. Prior to awarding the projects for construction, the department shall obtain approval from the Guam Fishing and Boating Association of the plans for the ramp.

Section 4. The sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair of the Merizo Boat Launching Ramp. Any unexpended balance in the appropriation made in Section 9 of Public Law 15-110 is reverted to the General Fund.
