AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000) TO PROVIDE RESIDENTIAL CARE FOR MENTALLY RETARDED CITIZENS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services, for the purpose of making a grant to an organization providing supervised home care services for the mentally retarded.

Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law 15-140 is amended to read:

"Section 5. There is appropriated from the General Fund Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$225,100) to the Department of Land Management for payment of just compensation to those persons whose property is needed in order to satisfy the real estate requirements of
