

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND  
DOLLARS (\$35,000) TO PROVIDE RESIDENTIAL  
CARE FOR MENTALLY RETARDED CITIZENS AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) is  
3 appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Department  
4 of Public Health and Social Services, for the purpose of making  
5 a grant to an organization providing supervised home care services  
6 for the mentally retarded.

7 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law 15-140 is amended to  
8 read:

9 "Section 5. There is appropriated from the General  
10 Fund Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand One Hundred Dollars  
11 (\$225,100) to the Department of Land Management for payment  
12 of just compensation to those persons whose property is  
13 needed in order to satisfy the real estate requirements of

1 the Guam Adult Correctional Facility. In acquiring such  
2 real property, the Governor shall pay Antonio P. and Maria  
3 F. Perez Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) for the home they  
4 shall be required to surrender to the government in  
5 conjunction with this project."

6 Section 3. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is  
7 appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Department  
8 of Education for the purpose of building two temporary classrooms  
9 at Brodie Memorial School.
