


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM
FOR THE HOTEL/RESTAURANT INDUSTRY IN THE GUAM
COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 11964.1 is added to the Government
3 Code to read:

4 "Section 11964.1. The Board shall establish a
5 coordinating committee for the hotel/restaurant industry
6 apprenticeship program. The coordinating committee shall
7 include representatives of the hotel and restaurant industry
8 on Guam and members of the staff of the Guam Community
9 College. The committee shall develop an apprenticeship
10 program for employees in the hotel/restaurant industry and
11 recommend rules and regulations to the Board in conjunction
12 with the program. The program shall provide that apprentices
13 shall be paid a wage not less than the applicable minimum

1 wage for on-the-job training. Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour
2 shall be paid by the employer and the remainder shall be
3 paid by the College."

4 Section 2. Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) is
5 appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Hotel/
6 Restaurant Apprenticeship Fund. The Guam Community College shall
7 be custodian of the Hotel/Restaurant Apprenticeship Fund and
8 annually shall report to the Legislature as to transactions
9 involving the Fund. The College shall pay its share for wages
10 for apprentices in the hotel and restaurant industry apprentice-
11 ship program from the Hotel/Restaurant Apprenticeship Fund. The
12 appropriation made in this Section shall be available for expen-
13 diture for two years, the period necessary for completion of
14 the program by the first class of students.

15 Section 3. A new Section 53571.1 is added to the Government
16 Code to read:

17 "Section 53571.1. Participation in the Apprenticeship
18 Training Program. A Corporate Qualifying Certificate shall
19 not be issued to an applicant which operates a hotel or
20 restaurant unless the applicant commits itself at the time
21 of application for such a certificate to participate in the
22 Hotel/Restaurant Industry Apprenticeship Program administered
23 by the Guam Community College and to hire graduates of the
24 apprenticeship program when vacancies exist."
