AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$28,000) TO THE NURSE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Twenty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) to the Nurse Fund for the operation of the Guam Board of Nurses Examiners for the fiscal year ending 1931.

Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1 shall be satisfied by the transfer of lapses, unencumbered or unexpended appropriation of the General Fund made in Public Law 15-142.
