


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TWENTY
EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$28,000) TO THE
NURSE FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund the
3 sum of Twenty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) to the Nurse Fund
4 for the operation of the Guam Board of Nurses Examiners for the
5 fiscal year ending 1931.

6 Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1 shall be
7 satisfied by the transfer of lapses, unencumbered or unexpended
8 appropriation of the General Fund made in Public Law 15-142.
