AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 2200 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REAPPORTIONING THE DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 2200 of the Government Code, (which is
codified as Section 6101 of Title 3 of the Guam Code Annotated),
is smended to read:

"Section 2200 (6101). Cuam Legislature, description and apportionment thereof. (a) The Guam Legislature shall be a unicameral body consisting of twenty-one (21) members who shall be elected from legislative districts as hereinafter provided.

- (b) The term 'municipal district' as used berein shall mean municipal district as it is defined and described in Section 403 of Title 1 of the Guem Code Annotated.
- (c) The First Legislative District shall consist of the municipal districts of Yigo and Dededo and shall be entitled to seven (7) seats in the Guan Legislature.
- (d) The Second Legislative District shall consist of the municipal districts of Tamuning, Agama, Agama Heights, Mongmeng-Toto-Maite and Barrigads and shall be entitled to six (6) seats in the Guam Legislature.
- (a) The Third Legislative District shall consist of the municipal districts of Piti, Asan, Sinajana, Mangilao,

Chalan Pago-Ordot and Yone and shall be entitled to four (4) seats in the Guam Legislature.

(f) The Fourth Legislative District shall complet of the municipal districts of Santa Rita, Aget, Umates, Meriso, Inarajan, and Talofofo and shall be entitled to four (4) seats in the Guam Legislature."
