




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 2200  
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
REAPPORTIONING THE DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION  
OF THE MEMBERS OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2200 of the Government Code, (which is  
3 codified as Section 6101 of Title 3 of the Guam Code Annotated),  
4 is amended to read:

5 "Section 2200 (6101). Guam Legislature, description  
6 and apportionment thereof. (a) The Guam Legislature shall  
7 be a unicameral body consisting of twenty-one (21) members  
8 who shall be elected from legislative districts as  
9 hereinafter provided.

10 (b) The term 'municipal district' as used herein  
11 shall mean municipal district as it is defined and described  
12 in Section 403 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated.

13 (c) The First Legislative District shall consist of  
14 the municipal districts of Yigo and Dedede and shall be  
15 entitled to seven (7) seats in the Guam Legislature.

16 (d) The Second Legislative District shall consist of  
17 the municipal districts of Tamuning, Agaña, Agaña Heights,  
18 Mongmong-Toto-Maite and Barrigada and shall be entitled to  
19 six (6) seats in the Guam Legislature.

20 (e) The Third Legislative District shall consist of  
21 the municipal districts of Piti, Asan, Sinajana, Mangilao,

1 Chalan Fago-Ordot and Yona and shall be entitled to  
2 four (4) seats in the Guam Legislature.

3 (f) The Fourth Legislative District shall consist  
4 of the municipal districts of Santa Rita, Agat, Umatac,  
5 Meriso, Inarajan, and Talofofo and shall be entitled to  
6 four (4) seats in the Guam Legislature."
