




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR RECRUITMENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM OFF-ISLAND, FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES, FOR PROCUREMENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT AND TEXTBOOKS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1982 AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT TO REALLOCATE ITS FISCAL YEAR 1981 APPROPRIATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Education may make commit-
3 ments, not to exceed the sums indicated below for the recruitment
4 of instructional personnel from off-island, for contractual
5 services, and for procurement of instructional supplies, equip-
6 ment and placement of orders for library books and textbooks for
7 school year 1981/1982:

8	A. Off-Island Recruitment	\$ 60,000
9	B. Contractual	\$ 220,597
10	C. Supplies & Materials	\$1,033,101
11	D. Library	\$ 220,320
12	E. Instructional Equipment	\$ 527,718
13	F. Private Textbooks	\$ 144,270
14	G. Public Textbooks	\$ 763,400
15	TOTAL	\$2,969,206

1 Section 2. Funds available for off-island recruitment pur-
2 suant to Item A of Section 1, shall be committed only for
3 recruitment of personnel for positions for which no qualified,
4 certified local applicant has applied.

5 Section 3. The Department of Education is hereby authorized
6 to spend unexpended and unencumbered funds from the appropriation
7 made in Section 4 of Public Law 15-142 to satisfy the intent of
8 Section 1 of this Act. The Director shall report to the Legis-
9 lature all funds expended and encumbered as authorized by this
10 Act before August 30, 1981.
